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-On 3/10/2024, at approximately 0630 hours, I (Ofc Betz) was on foot patrol on the 100 block of Simonton St. While on foot patrol, I checked the 600 Front St, Key West Bottling Court, due to a high number of trespassers and narcotics usage.

600 Front St is an area of shops at the corner of Front and Simonton. The area has two corridors that lead to the businesses. At the time of my check, no businesses in the complex were open and the complex has trespass warnings posted in clear and visible locations.

While on my check, I located five male subjects in the center of the court, passed the trespass warning signs. I approached the males while wearing my KWPB bicycle uniform, which has three inch lettering on the chest and an embroidered KWPB badge which identifies me as a police officer.

I explained to the subjects while I was there and making contact with them. The males were identified as Juan Rodriguez, Luis Garcia, Trevor Meier, Daniel Aguilar and the other remained unidentified.

During the encounter, I had to explain to the individuals that they were trespassing and informed them they were detained. While waiting for additional officers, I observed Juan Rodriguez place a dark colored item in his mouth. Due to the high narcotics use in the area, I believed the item was a baggie of narcotics. I ordered Rodriguez to "spit it out" Rodriguez did not comply. I displayed my Taser to him, in hopes of getting him to comply. Rodriguez did not comply.

While I waited for backup, several of the subjects began moving around. I ordered them to sit on their butts. Ofc Stevens arrived on scene.

Once Ofc Stevens arrived, Luis Garcia decided to attempt to flee. Garcia stood and began to run toward the Simonton St exit. I tackled Garcia as he made the corner of the first store. Garcia and I ended up in a shrubbery. Ofc Stevens came to assist. I ordered Garcia to put his hands behind his back. Garcia appeared to be reaching for something. I ordered Garcia to "stop reaching". I gave Garcia two closed handed strikes to his right shoulder to gain compliance. I then pulled my Taser and ordered him again to put his hands behind his back. Garcia complied. I placed Garcia into handcuffs. Garcia did not sustain injury during the struggle.

While I took Garcia into custody, Juan Rodriguez and the unknown subject fled the area. Ofc Stevens was able to keep the other two seated by advising they would be "Tazed" if they ran.

During a search incident to arrest, I located a baggie of a white powdery substance in the right rear pocket of Garcia. I field tested the substance for cocaine. The substance field tested positive.

Ofc Arguello, who arrived on scene, transported Garcia to MCDC for me.

Since Garcia did enter and remain at 600 Front St, Key West Bottling Court, which is a posted property and he was there outside the hours of normal business, Garcia was in violation of FSS 810.09.

Since Garcia did attempt to flee after being detained for a lawful investigation, Garcia did violate FSS 843.02.

Since Garcia was in possession of FTP cocaine, Garcia was in violation of FSS 893.13-6a.

Ofc Stevens, during a search incident to arrest, located cocaine on Daniel Aguilar and placed him under arrest. (see Ofc Stevens Supplemental)

Ofc Howell and PO Roman placed Meier under arrest for trespassing.

Ofc Stevens also located a dark colored baggie under Aguilar. The baggie looked to be similar to what I observed Rodriguez place in his mouth. Rodriguez, who was seated next to Aguilar, did have his hand in the area the baggie was found. We also located a different style baggie of cocaine in the area Meier and the unknown suspect were located. The two other baggies were taken for destruction since I was unable to prove ownership.

I will obtain a warrant for Rodriguez in reference to trespass and resisting.

On March 10, 2024, Ofc Betz announced over his police radio that he had encountered five individuals at Lily Pulitzer, 600 Front St and I advised that I would back him up. While en route, Ofc Betz added that he had one of the individuals at Taser-point and they had shoved something into their mouth.

Upon arrival, I located Ofc Betz in a courtyard area behind 600 Front St. There were four males sitting on the ground. As I approached, one of the males (later identified as Louis GARCIA) stood up and started running through the courtyard and Ofc Betz and I gave chase. As GARCIA ran, his feet started slipping and Ofc Betz managed to grab him and they fell into some bushes on the border of the rum distillery. I drew my Taser and switched it on, pointing it at GARCIA. Ofc Betz and I gave repeated loud verbal commands to GARCIA to put his hands behind his back, but he continued to resist and struggle. While we struggled with trying to detain GARCIA, another individual (later identified as Juan Miguel RODRIGUEZ FERNANDEZ) stood up and started running to Front St. I was unable to give chase as I was assisting Ofc Betz. Once FERNANDEZ had exited the courtyard, I lost sight of him. I requested additional units to the scene to assist and I updated dispatch on what was occurring. I advised the remaining two individuals that I would use my Taser if they attempted to leave and they indicated that they understood.

Once Ofc Betz had detained GARCIA in handcuffs, Ofcs Arguello and Brabc arrived. Ofc Betz secured GARCIA in Ofc Arguello's car and he directed me to search the remaining individuals as they were being charged with trespassing. I searched Trevor MEIER and he had nothing of evidentiary value on his person. I then searched Daniel AGUILAR. After I had searched his pockets, I directed him to remove his shoes. As he removed his right sneaker, a small plastic baggie of white powder fell out of the shoe. He then removed the other shoe and, suspecting the white powder to be cocaine, I placed AGUILAR in handcuffs. I retrieved his shoes and escorted him to my police vehicle. I then field-tested the white powder and it field-tested positive for cocaine and I placed AGUILAR under arrest.

After consulting with Ofc Betz, he showed me the No Trespassing sign clearly posted on the wall of the courtyard.

AGUILAR continued to be cooperative as I drove him to MCDC without incident.

My bodyworn camera (BWC) was activated and recording during the incident and the footage will be uploaded to the evidence server. I packaged the drug evidence and submitted it to the Key West Police Evidence Custodian for submission along with a request for analysis by FDLE.
