A RESOLUTION OF THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA), AWARDING THE BID OF KENCO SIGNS & AWNING, LLC IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #23-011 EXTERIOR SIGNAGE SYSTEM - KEY WEST HISTORIC SEAPORT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$299,860.00; WAIVING Α MINOR **INCONSISTENCY**; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY THE BUDGET TRANSFER; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, The CRA advertised a request for BIDs for ITB #23-011 Exterior Signage System - Key West Historic Seaport, and three bids were opened on June 14, 2023. City staff reviewed and determined Kenco Signs & Awning, LLC to be lowest responsive bid, and that a minor inconsistency had no tangible impact on the bid; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 12, 2023, the Key West Bight Management District Board made a recommendation to the CRA to award a contract in accordance with documents contained in the ITB to Kenco Signs & Awning, LLC through Resolution KWB #23-13; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CAROLINE STREET CORRIDOR AND BAHAMA VILLAGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS FOLLOWS: Section 1: That the bid of Kenco Signs & Awning, LLC in response to "ITB #23-011 Exterior Signage System - Key West Historic Seaport" in the amount not to exceed \$299,860.00 is hereby awarded.

<u>Section 2</u>: That a minor inconsistency in the original submitted bid is waived.

Section 3: That the project is budgeted in the amount of \$250,000 in account #405-7504-575-6300 (KB75042203). The Key West Bight Management District Board recommends a budget transfer in the amount of \$49,860 from reserves to #405-7504-575-6300 (KB75042203) along with any related budget amendments or adjustments.

<u>Section 4</u>: That the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with documents contained in the bid package on behalf of the City of Key West, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Agency. Passed and adopted by the Caroline Street Corridor and Bahama
