Introduction

The City Manager's Office requests the approval of a Noise Exemption for a fundraising event taking place at the 200 block of Ann Street and the end of Greene Street on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. benefiting Womankind.

Background

The City Manager's Office has received an application from "Womankind, Inc." partnering with Tattoos & Scars Saloon to hold a fundraiser event. Alcohol will be sold at Tattoos & Scars Saloon while Womankind will be setting up a silent auction tent starting at the 200 block of Ann Street on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. There will be amplified music with a DJ booth. Per Ordinances 6-86, property owners will be notified of the requested noise exemption times within one hundred feet from the event. The applicant has agreed to abide by City Codes and Ordinances, including providing insurance.

Procurement

There will be no additional expenses to the city as all service costs (Police/Fire/Community Services) are covered by the applicant, based on the Special Event Matrix.

Recommendation

The City Manager's Office recommends the Mayor & City Commission approve the requested noise exemption for the fundraiser event "Tats for Tatas", on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
