A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING MEL FISHER MARITIME HERITAGE SOCIETY, INC. TO CONDUCT THE 26TH ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION OF THE FINDING OF THE ATOCHA ON FRIDAY, JULY 15, 2011 DURING THE HOURS OF 3:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M. AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF THE 200 BLOCK OF DUVAL STREET FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 10:00 P.M.; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 1:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M.; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society Inc. has applied to the City for a Special Event Permit for a “26th Year Celebration of finding the “Atocha” Friday, July 15, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this event shall take place on the 200 block of Duval Street between the hours of 3:00 p.m. till 9:00 p.m; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida:

SECTION 1. That the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct the 26th Anniversary Celebration the finding of the Atocha on the day and during the hours stated above; **PROVIDED** that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and that 25 % of gross revenue or \$1,000.00, whichever is more, shall be donated to the Mel Fisher Maritime Museums Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the closure of the 200 block of Duval Street on the date and during the hours

stated above.

SECTION 3. That the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society Inc. is granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and time herein described.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, The Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society, Inc is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That the Mel Fisher Maritime Heritage Society, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side;

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
