Re: 2016-05 KWBB / schooner Western Union Restoration Progress Report

- **A.** Attached is a copy of a June 6 letter from SWUPS to the CKW City Mgr. Jim Scholl requesting a release of \$40,000 of the \$250,000 CKW SWU matching funds (for the now approved SOF grant) being held in escrow by the city.
- **B.** The FL Dept. of State, Historic Preservation Bureau approved (in writing) a request from SWUPS to begin work on the schooner now in advance of the July 1 state grant effective date. The work are the necessary repairs to transit the vessel safely from KW to Tarpon and the transit expense to Tarpon.
- **C.** There are less than 3-weeks remaining for the schooner to prepare for and conduct a successful sea trial and then depart for Tarpon Springs.
 - **a.** The schooner will have a 3-day motor trip across the gulf to the (MarPro) Tarpon Springs boatyard for a scheduled restoration to begin July 1.
