Recycling Pilot Program Update

- Simpler signage was provided to participating businesses that requested them.
- Fury has been provided with recycling slim jim bins and signage for use or larger boats.
- Damaged Greene St. Recycling dumpster for glass, metal and plastic replaced.
- Green St. cardboard baler fully operational and cardboard dumpster removed.
- Have not been made aware that recycling efforts have increased the need for additional service days, carts or larger facilities.
- Participating business outside of the bight area has not opened a recycling account.
- Participating business inside the bight area has inquired about opening a recycling account.

Sewer/Storm/GIS

- 1 Building permit review in TRAKIT for stormwater.
- Training time with Utility Administrator & Utility Admin Asst to cross train on certain workflows.
- Met with ESRI Rep to discuss options utilizing Arc Map to track or monitor transient advertisements.
