A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING FINNEGAN'S WAKE IRISH PUB & EATERY TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL ST. PATRICK'S DAY CELEBRATION ON MARCH 17, 2012, FROM 10:00 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT; PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF JAMES STREET BETWEEN GRINNELL AND MARGARET STREETS FROM 10:00 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FROM 10:00 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West Florida;

SECTION 1. That Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery is hereby granted permission to conduct St. Patrick's Day Celebration on the day and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager; and that 25% of gross revenue or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater, shall be donated to the Shriners/Masons.

SECTION 2. That Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery is hereby granted permission for the closure of James Street between Grinnell and Margaret Streets on the date and during the hours stated above.

SECTION 3. That Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery is granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place

and time herein described.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 (b) of the Key West Code of Ordinances, Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery event is verified by staff with a follow up that 25% of the net proceeds go to charity.

SECTION 6. That Finnegan's Wake Irish Pub & Eatery will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
