REQUEST: The applicant is requesting removal of the Poinciana tree.

NOTES: This tree is growing in a city ROW planter. The tree has compromised unions and cavities exposed to infestation. There is visible decay throughout the stem of the tree. There is also an active beehive. The planter is not suitable for a canopy tree due to the size of the planter, overhead wires, and the proximity of the adjacent building. Urban Forestry Recommends a small tree with a spread of 8-20 feet.

Examples would be Pigeon Plum, White Ironwood, Buttonwood, Bahama Strongbark or a palm such as the Leucothrinax morrisii/Key thatch palm.
