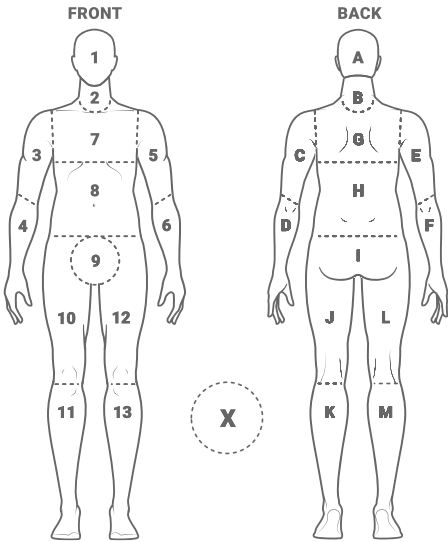

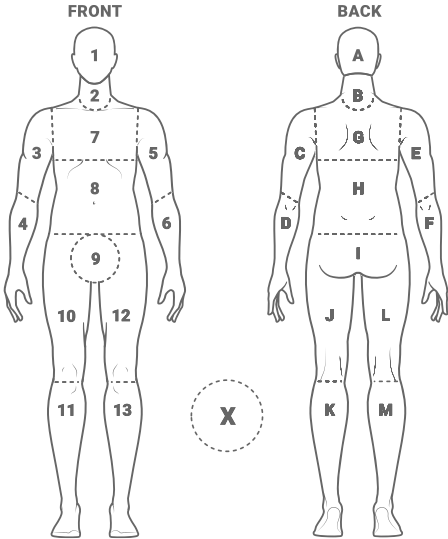

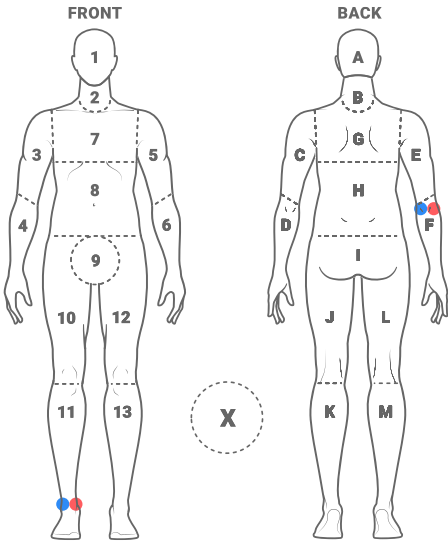
Response Action

The subject was given a lawful verbal command by Sergeant Stutz to step away from the area where officers were conducting an active investigation. The subject refused to comply and continued to approach Sergeant Stutz in an aggressive manner. The subject then charged toward Sergeant Stutz while yelling, demonstrating aggressive resistance by taking physically threatening actions and attempting to close distance with the officer in a hostile manner.

Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT

On Saturday, October 25, 2025, at approximately 0043 Hours, Sergeant Stutz and Officer Lashley were working the Fantasy Fest Street Fair Detail. They responded from Caroline Street to back Officer Flores, who advised over the radio that she had a physical disturbance in front of Teasers 218 Duval St.

On their arrival, they observed that Officer Flores was surrounded by four to six males who were screaming at her as she attempted to conduct her investigation.

Officer Lashley placed himself between Officer Flores and the males and issued loud verbal commands for them to step back. One of the males, later identified as Marcus Hosfield, refused to move back and pushed forward toward Officer Lashley.

Officer Lashley redirected Hosfield by pushing him away and issuing loud verbal commands to step back. Sergeant Stutz stepped between Hosfield and Officer Lashley and gave him loud verbal commands to step back and leave the area so Officer Lashley could redirect his attention back to the group around Officer Flores. Hosfield began to step back, but then tensed his arms, clenched his fists, and attempted to walk past Sergeant Stutz. Sergeant Stutz continued to give Hosfield loud verbal commands to step back. Hosfield then tried to pass Sergeant Stutz again. Sergeant Stutz redirected Hosfield to the ground with a modified hip toss.

Hosfield was taken into custody and walked to the Monroe County Detention Center Processing Center at 510 Greene St. I spoke to Hosfield while he was being processed. I asked if he was injured, and he told me he had a scratch on his right elbow and a small one on the outside of his right ankle. His injuries are consistent with being taken to the ground on his right side.
