A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THAT THE CONTINUED DETERIORATION OF THE SUNRISE CANAL MAY AFFECTING CONSTITUTE NUISANCE Α PUBLIC'S HEALTH AND WELFARE; DIRECTING STAFF TO SEEK GRANT FUNDING AND OBTAIN FOR MAINTENANCE PERMITS DREDGING RESTORE THE CANAL AND ABATE THE NUISANCE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds continued deterioration of the conditions of the Sunrise Canal poses the potential to create a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, the Sunrise Canal has become clogged with organic material in recent years resulting in a condition where maintenance dredging should be performed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Commission has determined that the continued deterioration of the condition of the Sunrise Canal may constitute a nuisance.

Section 2: That City staff is hereby directed to seek grant funding and obtain permits for maintenance dredging to
