On 04/19/19, at approximately 0251hrs, I (Ofc. B. DeHanas) was dispatched to an intoxicated subject at 830 Truman Avenue (Silver Palms Hotel).

This incident involves Roman Viniukov and his girlfriend Yenisleydis Rodriguez. Marko Jovic (Sliver Palms Hotel staff) called in reference to Roman and Yenisleydis being extremely intoxicated in the hotel.

I arrived with Ofc. E. Cuneo and Ofc. S. Perez. (Ofc. V. Arguello arrived later). Marko escorted us to the second floor of the hotel, where I saw Yenisleydis sitting and slumped over on the ground at the end of the hallway on the second floor of the hotel. Roman was with Yenisleydis. While Marko was escorting us to Yenisleydis and Roman, I noticed what appeared and smelled to be vomit on the floor of the hallway. Yenisleydis was barely verbal and could not stand. Ofc. E. Cuneo requested rescue to respond to the scene to evaluate Yenisleydis. I knew we would have to get Yenisleydis to the ground floor. I went to get a rolling chair to assist in moving Yenisleydis to the ground level, as she could barely walk.

Shortly after assisting Yenisleydis to the ground level, emergency medical services (EMS) personnel arrived to evaluate Yenisleydis. I requested Roman to move away, so that EMS personnel could effectively evaluate Yenisleydis. Roman wanted to stay with Yenisleydis and made this verbally known by telling me "no". I attempted to escort Roman away. Roman still did not want to move away from Yenisleydis and continued to make this verbally known. I placed Roman into handcuffs and attempted to have him sit on the concrete away from Yenisleydis. Roman did not want to sit on the ground and was actively trying to pull away from me. I attempted to perform a leg sweep on Roman. Ofc. E. Cuneo assisted me with controlling Roman. Ofc. E. Cuneo and I redirected Roman to the ground. Later, Ofc. E. Cuneo told me he attempted to perform a leg sweep as well on Roman (see Ofc. E. Cuneo's supplemental report).

I notified Sgt. J. Stockton over Key West Police Department Communications (COMM 1), that he would need to respond for a response to resistance incident. Ofc. E. Cuneo and I maintained control over Roman until Sgt. J. Stockton arrived. When Sgt. J. Stockton arrived, he asked Roman if he was injured. Roman stated he did not need medical attention. At that time, I did not notice any injuries to Roman. Sgt. J. Stockton applied a restraint device to Roman's lower legs. Sgt. J. Stockton, Ofc. S. Perez and I escorted Roman to the back of my patrol car.

Simultaneously while this incident was occurring, Ofc. V. Arguello was assisting EMS personnel with Yenisleydis next to me. I could hear Yenisleydis screaming and could see her becoming combative with EMS personnel and Ofc. V. Arguello. Yenisleydis was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center by EMS personnel.

I transported Roman to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident (MCDC). While at the MCDC, I noticed a red abrasion to the left side of Roman's forehead. I took a photograph of Roman's forehead and later uploaded it onto the Key West Police Department AXON Server.

My AXON body worn camera was activated during this incident. I later uploaded my BWC footage onto the Key West Police Department AXON Server.

As we got back to the Hotel I noticed Officer Cuneo and Officer Dehanas in a scuffle with the white male. The female was been attend by EMT and became combative, Officer Arguello and I, took control of the female and lay her down on the stretcher. While on the stretcher the female became very aggressive and I assisted EMT personnel on tying her down to the stretcher.

On 04/19/2019 at 0241 hours I, Ofc. Cuneo was dispatched to 830 Truman Ave in reference to intoxicated people. Once I arrived, I was assisted by Ofc. Perez and Ofc. Dehanas. The front desk personnel stated the male and female were on the second floor and they were, "Trashed". As we walked to the location of the couple, I did observe a puddle of throw up in the hall way.

We then contacted the male and the female. The female was in a seated position on the floor hunched over. The male was at the end of the hallway. At this point we called for the male to come back over to the female. Observing the female, I called for EMS to come and check her out as I thought she could have been possibly drugged. We attempted to move the female to the first floor. The male grabbed the female from the rear, and I grabbed her hands. The male walked backwards with the female. Ofc. Dehanas then arrived a short time later with a rolling chair. The female was then placed onto the chair and was rolled to and elevator. After reaching the first floor she was rolled to the front of the building where we waited for EMS. Ofc. Arguello arrived a short time later. At this point I turned off my BWC as it was a medical call.

Once EMS arrived, I briefed them on what we had witnessed. I began to assist with the stretcher as it had tipped over. At the same time EMS began their assessment. The female started to become combative. I looked over and observed Ofc. Dehanas began to place handcuffs on the male. I assisted him in detaining the male. After the handcuffs were placed on the male, Ofc. Dehanas moved the male a few feet away from the female. Ofc. Dehanas then attempted to sit the male down, however; he began to resist and not comply with the orders he was given. I then walked over to the male to assist with getting him seated. I attempted to perform a leg sweep on the male. As I attempted the leg sweep, I was holding the male and looking at his arms. During the performance of the leg sweep, it felt as if the male had countered it and I began to fall to the ground. I landed on my right knee and both Ofc. Dehanas and then restrained the male until other officers could assist us. The male was irate and screaming at officers. My BWC had fallen off and fell to the ground.

At the same time, Ofc. Perez and Ofc. Arguello were attempting to restrain the female whom EMS was working on.

SGT Stockton was notified about a response to resistance. The male was later hobbled and placed in the rear of Ofc. Dehanas's patrol vehicle.

Upon, returning to the scene I noticed that Rodriguez was pulling away from rescue and her boyfriend, Viniukowv, Roman was next to her. I instructed Viniukowv to move away so Rescue could work on Rodriguez, he refused. We handcuffed Viniukowv. Rodriguez attempted to get up, I grabbed her and assisted rescue in strapping her in the stretcher. I rode in the ambulance due to Rodriguez's behavior. Nothing further to report.
