*****JUVENILE FELONY ARREST*****

On Thursday, 04/20/23, at approximately 1120hrs, I (Ofc. T. Clark, full KWPD uniform, with badge displayed), while conducting School Resource Officer duties at Key West High School, 2100 Flagler Ave, observed a trespasser in the courtyard during lunch.

*****BWC later activated*****

I saw Elmar Raymundo, known to me from numerous contacts and previous arrests talking with students. I knew Elmar to not be conducting legitimate school activity, as he was supposed to have left campus already after 3rd period. Elmar has been warned numerous times by myself and KWHS administration that he would be subject to arrest if he did not leave after his classes were finished.

I confirmed with Assistant Principal Yanelyis Ballard that Elmar was to not be on KWHS property. I asked Elmar to leave. Elmar exhibited glossy/watery eyes and smelled of freshly burned marijuana. I know Elmar to have been arrested in the past for narcotics violations. I also know Elmar to be currently on probation for multiple offenses. As I escorted Elmar, the odor of marijuana was overwhelming. Elmar does not have a medical marijuana card.

I told Elmar to go to my office. Once in my office I told Elmar he was going to be searched. Elmar told me he had a Delta 8 vaporizer on him. Elmar exhibited the odor of marijuana on his breath. I located the Delta 8 vaporizer and continued my search of his person. In Elmar's phone case I located a green leafy substance, that held the overwhelming odor of marijuana (later FTP marijuana).

I began giving Elmar lawful commands to turn and place his hands behind his back, so that I may place him under arrest. Elmar refused my lawful commands and began to argue with me. When I attempted to take physical control of Elmar's right wrist to place him in handcuffs he pulled away from my grasp. Elmar continued to struggle away from my grasp. Elmar refused to obey lawful commands to stop resisting arrest and place his hands behind his back. Elmar pulled and turned away from me, as I struggled to safely place him under arrest without harm. I attempted to grasp Elmar's shoulder as he pulled away grabbing the back of his shirt and neck.

Elmar continued his active physical resisting, pulling and turning. My radio broke free from my vest during the struggle and I could not request Officer assistance. I attempted to pin Elmar against the wall and chairs in my office so that I may place him under arrest. Elmar pushed my hands away, pulled his hands toward his chest and caused my BWC camera to fly from my chest. I attempted to gain physical control with a straight arm takedown as Elmar pulled and turned.

During the struggle to place Elmar under arrest he grabbed my leg and attempted to pull me from my feet.

Even after being pinned to the ground Elmar continued to disobey lawful commands to place his hands behind his back. Elmar would push himself up from the ground and pull away from my grasp. I was able to get a hold of my radio and request a back up officer. I placed Elmar in handcuffs.

During the course of Elmar's physical resistance and battering me, I felt great pain in my hip and leg, I will seek treatment at a later time.

Ofc. S. Standerwick arrived and attempted to help me control Elmar, who still attempted to stand and still physically resisted.

During the course, Elmar began telling me how he was going to be out of jail soon and would see me on Monday.

Sgt. C. Williams responded at my request for a Response to Resistance. I was advised Elmar declined injury and EMS.

I notified Elmars guardian Jessica Lariz of this incident, due to his father not answering the phone. I was later advised she was able to pass along Elmars arrest.

I also notified Elmar`s Probation Officer Nancy Masry of his arrest.

I also notified KWHS Administration of Elmar`s arrest.

Elmar is currently on probation. Elmar has been physically arrested in the past. Elmar does not qualify for the Juvenile Citation program. Elmar has received a Notice To Appear in the past. I have learned during my tenure with KWHS that Elmar has not been attending his court ordered drug testing as required. Elmar is habitually truant in school and has been searched numerous times for the odor of marijuana and arrested. Elmar is habitually exhibiting being under the influence of a narcotic. Elmar is habitually defiant. Elmar openly taunts the Juvenile Criminal Justice system and brags about not being held accountable. I have notified DJJ of violations and concerns in the past.

During the course of this incident I found probable cause to charge Elmar with the following:

Battery on Law Enforcement Officer:: I, Ofc. Clark in full KWPD uniform with badge displayed, during the lawful performance of my duties, was grabbed by the leg by Elmar (captured on BWC), my hands were shoved away by Elmar as well.

Resisting without violence:: I, Ofc. Clark in full KWPD uniform with badge displayed, during the lawful performance of my duties, issued numerous verbal commands for Elmar to place his hands behind his back so he may be arrested, which he actively physically refused to do, actively pushing and pulling away from my grasp.

Trespassing School:: Elmar had no legitimate purpose to be on campus during school lunch as his lesson ended 3rd period. Elmar has been warned numerous times to leave campus after class or he would be subject to arrest.

Possession of Marijuana under 20grams:: Elmar did have in his possession FTP marijuana, located in his cellular phone case.

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia: Elmar did have FTP marijuana concealed in his cellular phone case. I have warned Elmar about this tactic in the past and did not criminally charge him the last time for it when he was arrested for a warrant.

Elmar was transported to jail by Ofc. B. Leahy.

On 4/20/2023 at approximately 1130 hours I, Ofc Standerwick, was working the SSO detail at Key West High School.

I was in the courtyard observing the lunch hour when SRO Clark called out on KWPD dispatch channel one asking for assistance in his office. I responded to KWPD dispatch that I was in route to the office, and I activated my BWC. When I entered the office SRO Clark had Elmar Raymundo (Juvenile DOB 8/27/2007) in the corner of the office handcuffed. Raymundo was extremely belligerent and wasn't listening to the loud verbal commands to stop resisting that SRO Clark was giving him. Raymundo demonstrated active physical resistance by thrashing his body side to side and was actively pulling away from SRO Clark. When I went to place hands on him, he pushed forward trying to escape my grasp. SRO Clark and I attempted to get a grasp of Reymundo, however he kept physically resisting both SRO Clark and I, by thrashing his body about so violently that he knocked my BWC off my chest mount. At this point Reymundo was directed to the floor of the office to prevent him hurting himself, or damaging school resources.
