## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

RE: Non-renewal of Lease for Jay Weisinger DBA Nature's Treasures

#### **ACTION:**

This is a request to deny a lease renewal for 201 William Street, Suite 110 expiring December 31, 2011 between the CRA and Jay Weisinger B/B/A Nature's Treasures.

#### **BACKROUND:**

The CRA entered into a lease agreement in January of 2007 for the space located at 201 William, Suite 110 for the purposes of retail sales of a nautical line of merchandise including jewelry, pirate treasure coins plus other pirate related merchandise, sunglasses, other nautical items.

On November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 staff received written notice from Mr. Weisinger indicating that he intended to exercise his option to renew the lease. This Tenant does not have a unilateral option to renew the lease but can enter into negotiations to renew their lease per Section 3, however this was not requested nor were negotiations entered into within the stated time frame, excerpted here as follows:

Right to Renew – This Lease may be renewed for an additional term of five (5) years upon rent and terms to be negotiated by the parties in accordance with the City of Key West Code of Ordinances. The rent and terms of the renewal term must be acceptable to both the LANDLORD and the TENANT in their absolute discretion and must be set forth in written addendum to this Lease. If the parties fail for any reason whatsoever to agree upon and enter into such addendum at least 120 days prior to the end of the initial term of this Lease, then any obligations that the parties may have pursuant to this section to negotiate renewal terms shall cease and LANDLORD shall be free to lease the Demised Premises to the general public upon such rent and terms as it deems appropriate.

Additionally, whenever the City or CRA considers a lease renewal, City Ordinance 2-941 (d) also states the following:

"Whenever the city commission is to consider a lease renewal, the city manager shall submit to the city commission a report on total lease payments over the term of the lease and a history of the city's or CRA's leasing experience with the tenant, including a chronicle of lease violations and payment delinquencies, if any.

Mr. Weisinger is not in default of any lease payments but there are multiple lease violations that contribute to the request to deny a lease renewal at this time. These are evidenced by a



chronicle of the recorded events as well as a copy of an injunction for protection against repeated violence that are attached here for your reference.

The first material event was the injunction against repeated violence which was issued in December of 2007, the first year of the lease. Most recently police were called on two occasions in July and again in October for similar complaints that took place at the property while on November 26, 2011 he was also arrested for a misdemeanor count of touch or strike. Staff has experienced this aggressive behavior on numerous occasions and has also witnessed this same behavior towards other tenants and patrons alike.

Mr. Weisinger also received a default notice in August of 2010 citing three lease violations which relate to the display of merchandise outside of this premises, use of banners, and t-shirt sales as noted in the attached correspondence.

These occurrences also constitute default of Section 6 ((b) and (e) of the lease which state:

- (b) With respect to the Property, not to display any merchandise, solicit business or distribute advertising material beyond the Demised Premises, nor in any manner use any part of the Common Areas for purposes other than for their intended common use and not to obstruct any part thereof.
- (e) Not to use the Demised Premises or permit the same to be used in any manner which violates any law, ordinance or constitutes a nuisance; for lodging purposes; that may injure the reputation of the Property or annoy, inconvenience or damage its patrons or other TENANT'S; or that would constitute an extra-hazardous use or violate any insurance policy of TENANT, LANDLORD or any other TENANT in the Property or increase the cost thereof.

#### **OPTIONS:**

- 1. The Board can approve a lease renewal and staff will prepare a lease
- 2. The Board can elect to deny a lease renewal and advertise for letters of interest to obtain a new tenant for this location pursuant to the FL statute.

**FINANCIAL:** In the event that the Bight Board elects to solicit letters of interest there will be a deficiency in the budgeted annual rent depending on how long it takes to re-lease the space. The annual base rent is currently \$12,398.11

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff strongly urges support for the denial of a lease renewal wherein the tenant has on multiple occasions has been in default of the terms of the lease. Mr. Weisinger has shown that he is a catalyst for discontent and exhibits repeated aggressive behavior towards tenants, patrons and staff. It is the totality of his actions and pattern of behavior that result in staff's request to deny a lease renewal.



- Should any Florida law enforcement officer having jurisdiction have probable cause to believe that Respondent has knowingly violated this injunction, the officer may arrest Respondent, confine him/her in the county jail without bail, and shall bring him/her before the Initial Appearance Judge on the next regular court day so that Respondent can be dealt with according to law. The arresting agent shall notify the State Attorney's Office immediately after arrest. THIS INJUNCTION IS ENFORCEABLE IN ALL COUNTIES OF FLORIDA AND LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS MAY EFFECT ARRESTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 901.15(6), FLORIDA STATUTES.
- 3. Reporting alleged violations. If Respondent violates the terms of this injunction and there has not been an arrest, Petitioner may contact the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the county in which the violation occurred and complete an affidavit in support of the violation or Petitioner may contact the State Attorney's office for assistance in filing an action for indirect civil contempt or indirect criminal contempt. Upon receiving such a report, the State Attorney is hereby appointed to prosecute such violations by indirect criminal contempt proceedings, or the State Attorney may decide to file a criminal charge, if warranted by the evidence.
- 4. Respondent, upon service of this injunction, shall be deemed to have knowledge of and to be bound by all matters occurring at the hearing and on the face of this injunction.
- 5. The temporary injunction, if any, entered in this case is extended until such time as service of this injunction is effected upon Respondent.

On July 29, 2011, I was dispatched to Nature's Treasures at 201 William St, Key West, FL, in reference to a follow-up investigation. Upon arrival, I met with Ira WEISINGER, who told me that he has been involved in an ongoing feud with the Sebago sales booth located near his store. He told me that David POINDEXTER, who sits at the Sebago booth has been verbally abusive to him for approximately six (6) weeks. He said that this started when he made a suggestion to the Western Union sales operators to move to the Sebago location when Sebago closes. WEISINGER said that this upset POINDEXTER, to the point that he became verbally abusive towards WEISINGER, using loud profanity. WEISINGER said that he called police on July 28, 2011, because, at approximately 9:30am on this date, POINDEXTER showed him two (2) bags contained an unknown substance, saying that he would pour sugar into WEISINGER's vehicle's fuel tanks. WEISINGER told me that he was issued a CAD# (612090169). WEISINGER said that he would like to seek civil remedies against POINDEXTER. I gave him a case number.

I spoke with POINDEXTER who told me that he believes that WEISINGER is mentally unstable. He said that he has never antagonized WEISINGER, but that many of the tenants who rent space at the marina have issues with WEISINGER. POINDEXTER has said that WEISINGER often stands near him, video-taping him. He said that on July 28, 2011, WEISINGER called for City Code Compliance officers to come to the scene, which they did. He said that WEISINGER often comes out of his store, yelling profanity at POINDEXTER and that he would like to seek civil remedies against WEISINGER. I gave POINDEXTER a case number.

I was also flagged down by POINDEXTER's employer, Paul MCGRAIL. He told me that he has seen WEISINGER acting irrationally on numerous occasions, using profanity. He also said that up to four (4) other tenants at the Key West Bight have restraining orders against WEISINGER.




