The City Manager acknowledged the Finance Director and his team for their good work. Mayor Cates also acknowledged the assistance of Assistant City Managers Mark Finigan and David Fernandez as well as the City Manager for their hard work.

City Attorney's Report

City Attorney Shawn Smith also recognized the diligence and hard work the City Manager has done over the last five years to get the City where it is today.

Mr. Smith called for a Closed Session for the Sunset Marina Residents Case CAK 11-911. He was anticipating scheduling the date after the new City Manager is on board.

Mr. Smith reported he met with Mr. Vitas today and discussed a number of things. He wanted to get direction from the Commission regarding specific provisions of the contract. He would attempt to have a working document ready for the Commission on June 19th.

Commissioner Johnston requested inclusion of the medical benefits and to look at relocation expenses.

Commissioner Wardlow wanted to see a cap on the relocation expenses. He also wanted to see a three year contract with a one-year option on both sides and a one year probation period.

Commissioner Wardlow confirmed that the salary would be consistent with the advertisement.

Mr. Smith commented on a severance package being consistent with current statutory provision.

Mr. Smith commented that he had the opportunity to visit the new children's park at Higgs Beach and complimented City Commission and the County Commission for the new park.

Commissioner Yaniz also commented that posted at the new Higgs Beach Park is a regulation that an adult must be accompanied by a child to enter the playground area.

City Manager's Report

Mr. Scholl reported on the old Easter Seal property for possible KOTS relocation.

Mr. Scholl reported that the Carrying Capacity Study had been completed. He stated Engineering and Planning, in conjunction with the Legal Department, were preparing ordinance changes that would come before the Commission.

Mr. Scholl reported that the budget preparation would begin the next day.

Commissioner Wardlow asked about the new walls at HOB and were they in compliance with that was agreed upon. Mr. Scholl would have staff confirm.
