**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RESCINDING THE
AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CREATION OF PARKING
SPACES ON THE 100 BLOCK OF SIMONTON STREET;
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, section 70-31(a) of the Code of Ordinances authorizes the City Manager to designate parking spaces, and to seek the advice and consent of the city commission for such decisions; and

WHEREAS, planned redevelopment of property in the 100-Block of Simonton Street included reconfiguration of driveways, which in turn was expected to expand the availability of public right-of-way for metered parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution 15-263, the City Commission authorized the creation of certain right-of-way metered parking spaces in the 100 block of Simonton Street; and

WHEREAS, there have been citizen complaints, and City staff has determined that the parking spaces impede the flow of traffic through Old Town Key West, and accordingly the parking spaces should be removed/rescinded; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the authorization to create right-of-way parking spaces within the 100 block of Simonton Street is hereby rescinded.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
