ACTION STATEMENT:

Monroe County Fire Rescue has replaced its inventory of Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA). The previous manufacturer was Scott Safety, Inc. Monroe County Fire Rescue has offered to donate to the Key West Fire Department their entire inventory of Scott SCBA equipment.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

During the past several years the department has endeavored to upgrade its equipment. This donation will provide opportunities to reallocate funds from equipment for our fire fighters' respiratory protection to other necessary equipment.

CITIZEN BENEFIT:

This donation assists the City's commitment; providing the equipment necessary for use in protecting their fire emergency services as they respond to calls for help.
