A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING "KEY WEST HALF MARATHON LLC" TO CONDUCT THEIR 26th ANNUAL KEY WEST HALF MARATHON AND 5K RUN STARTING WITH A REGISTRATION ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 12, FROM 3:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M. AND SATURDAY JANUARY 13, 2024, FROM NOON TO 6:00 PM AND THE HALF MARATHON ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 14, 2024, STARTING AT 6:30 A.M (SET UP 6:00 AM) AND A 5K ON SUNDAY, JANUARY 14, 2024, AT 7:00 AM AND ENDING AT NOON, AT THE HALF SHELL RAW BAR - 231 MARGARET ST; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN STREET CLOSURES THEREOF DURING THE EVENT; GRANTING A SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-86 OF THE ORDINANCES FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 7:30 A.M. PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FOR BY THE CITY MANAGER; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS The Key West Half Marathon LLC is hereby given permission to conduct their 25TH Annual Key West Half Marathon and 5K Run on Sunday, January 14, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of distribution of single-use polystyrene/plastic items, including but not

limited to single-use polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City."

SECTION 3. That permission is hereby granted to conduct the Key West Half Marathon and 5K on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED that all trash is adequately collected and contained; that a guarantee indemnifying the city is executed; that the organization meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That the Key West Half Marathon LLC. is hereby granted permission for the closure of certain streets throughout the city for the Half Marathon & 5K on the date and during the hours stated above. That the Key West Half Marathon and 5K will depart from Trumbo Road, closer to former MCSD bus depot on Sunday, January 14, 2024, starting at 6:30 a.m. for the Half Marathon and at 7:00 a.m. for the 5K. Both races will end up at 231 Margaret Street – Half Shell Raw Bar.

SECTION 5. That the Key West Half Marathon, LLC will be coordinating with the agencies outside of the City of Key West jurisdiction for their part in the race.

SECTION 6. That the Event organizers will adhere to the recycling plan of the city of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That the event organizer shall use spray chalk or another readily removable substance for all course markings placed on public property.

SECTION 8. That Key West Half Marathon, LLC is hereby granted a Special Event Permit under Section 6-86 of the Code of Ordinances for an event that will take place and herein

described.

SECTION 9.	That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and
