Original Narrative By Dustin Christina, 12/26/25 20:35

On 12/26/2025 at approximately 1842 hours I was dispatched to 314 SIMONTON ST, KEY WEST, FL 33040 in regard to a suspicious party outside a blue car breaking plates and acting weird.

Upon my arrival I located A blue Volkswagen 4 door sedan, beside that vehicle was a partly later identified as Evan W. Theune, a white male, born on 02/08/1987 who was smoking a cigar. As I approached the vehicle Theune moved toward me in an aggressive manner. I instructed him to stay put and not approach me, he said no. I then placed my arm out to create space and told him again to step back, he swatted at my hand and said not again. At this point I decided to detain Theune in handcuffs due to his aggressive nature and unwillingness to cooperate. As I moved in to detain Theune he grabbed at both my wrists, then making a fist and taking a fighting stance. I notified KWPD dispatch that Theune was fighting, I withdrew my department issued Taser turned it on and instructed Theune he would be Tased if he did not get on the ground. I continued this until back up officers arrive. The first to scene was Officer A. Lashley, at this point I holstered my Taser and went hands on to subdue and detain Theune. While doing so Theune continued to fight by head-butting me in the face, and pulling his arms away tucking them under him to prevent arrest. Officer Lashley then drive stunned Theune in the legs (see Officer Lashley's supplement for further) due to this I was able to secure his left arm. He continued to fight by trying to pull his left arm away and keeping his right arm under him.

Officer Lashley then drive stunned Theune in the lower back. This causes full NMI - Neuro-Muscular Incapacitation which provided myself and Officer K. Hansell the ability to secure Theune's right arm to which we were able to handcuff him. Once handcuffed he was moved to a patrol vehicle where he was scene by KWFD EMS.

Once cleared by EMS Theune was transported to the Lower keys Medical ER for further clearance. Once seen by the Doctor and cleared with only minor scrapes to his knee and face he was transported to the Monroe County Jail for booking.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 12/26/2025, Evan W. Theune did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 784.07-2B Battery on LEO, by actually and intentionally head-butting me while struggling to pull his hands from me as Ofc. Lashley and I were handcuffing Theune, while I was engaged in my legal, lawful duties as a uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 12/26/2025, Evan W. Theune did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.01 Resisting with Violence, by actually and purposely threatening to and attempting to initiate a physical altercation with Ofc. Lashly and me, while pushing Ofc. Lashly and me as well as head-butting me as we attempted to place Theune in handcuffs, while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 12/26/2025, Evan W. Theune did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting without Violence, by actually and purposely pulling way from me as I attempted to place Theune in handcuffs, while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

My BWC was active for this arrest.

Nothing further.

Supplemental Narrative By Adam Lashley, 12/26/25 21:03

On Friday 12/26/2025 at approximately 1850hours, I (Ofc. Lashley) heard Ofc. Christina stated he was fighting on the radio. I activated my emergency lights and sirens and traveled to Ofc. Christina's location at 314 Simonton St.

Upon my arrival, I noticed Ofc. Christina had his taser pointing toward a male subject. Once I approached, Ofc. Christina put his taser away. I told the male subject later identified as Evan Theune, to put his hands behind his back and he refused. I grabbed Evans' right wrist to place him into custody and Evan began to pull away and resist. I continued trying to gain compliance by giving Evan verbal commands to stop pulling away and stop resisting but he refused to cooperate. Around this time by body worn camera detached and fell onto the ground. Ofc. Christina and I escorted Evan to the ground.

Ofc. Christina and I rolled Evan over to his stomach and I placed both of my knees on Evan's legs to keep him from kicking me. Ofc. K. Hansell arrived at the location to assist. Evan put his hands under his stomach to avoid being placed into handcuff restraints. I commanded Evan to put his hands behind his back multiple times, or I was going to tase him. I drive stunned Evan in the mid-section of his back and Ofc. Christina was able to get Evan's left arm behind his back. I drive stunned Evan in the back of his right thigh and Ofc. Hansell was able to get Evan's right arm behind his back.

Evan was placed into handcuff restraints and secured inside of Ofc. Hansell's patrol vehicle.

I conducted an inventory search of the vehicle that Evan was previously driving and Arnolds Towing collected the vehicle.

My body worn camera was uploaded to evidence.com

Supplemental Narrative By Kathryn Hansell, 12/26/25 21:25

On 12/26/2025 at approximately 1849 hours I, Officer K. Hansell, heard Officer D. Christina say over COMM1 that he had a subject fighting him on Simonton St.

I immediately activated my emergency lights and siren and drove to his location. Upon arriving I observed a white male actively resisting Officers Christina and Lashley. The male was yelling and actively pulling his hands and arms in front of him so he could not be handcuffed. I exited my marked patrol vehicle and moved toward both officers and the subject as he continued to resist and yell.

As I made contact with the officers and the male, I bent down and placed my legs (shins) on the subject's right shoulder area. I told the subject to stop resisting and told him to put his hands behind his back. The male subject continued to pull his hands in front of him as he was on the ground mostly face down. The subject was attempting to roll on his back and I continued to tell him to put his hands behind his back. I told Officer Lashley to tase him again as the subject still was actively trying to pull away from our grips and yell. After being tased (drive stunned) I was able to move the subject's right arm behind his back. Officer Christina was able to move the subjects left arm to his back and handcuff him.

Officer Christina and myself stood the subject up on his feet and walked him across Simonton St to my marked patrol vehicle. The subject was searched and placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle. The subject's belongings, including a large sum of cash, keys, wallet and cell phone were placed in the back storage area of my patrol vehicle. The belongings were secured in my patrol vehicle until I reached the Monroe County Detention Center.

I transported the subject to Lower Keys Medical Center for medical treatment. The subject was treated and medically cleared for transport to the detention center. I transported the subject to the detention center without further incident.

Note that during the entire incident I drove a marked patrol vehicle and was wearing my Key West Police Department class B uniform with a badge and KWPD patches on my sleeves.

My BWC and in-car cameras were activated during the incident and downloaded for review.
