A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF 218 STORMWATER INLET FILTERS FROM SUNTREE TECHNOLOGIES, INC., VIA SOLE SOURCE PURCHASE IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY CODE SECTION 2-797(1), IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$236,099.00, IN ORDER TO COMPLETE A FEMA DISASTER RECOVERY PROJECT FOR STORMWATER CLEANING AND FUTURE HAZARD MITIGATION; APPROVING BUDGET TRANSFERS; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE INSTALLATION COST OF THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1) permits the purchase of goods and services without competition on a sole source basis under certain specified conditions; and

WHEREAS, installation of stormwater inlet filters is a required component to complete a stormwater system cleaning project funded substantially by FEMA after the 2005 storm season;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That City staff is authorized to waive competitive bidding and contract with Suntree Technologies for purchase and installation of 218 stormwater inlet filters on a sole source basis pursuant to Key West Code of Ordinances section 2-797(1), in an amount not to exceed \$236,099.00.

Section 2: That necessary budget transfers for FY 2011 are
hereby authorized to reflect additional anticipated stormwater
revenue in the amount of \$47,200.00.
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the
signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
