ACTION STATEMENT

Approving contract award for ITB #18-037 Tarpon Pier Repair – Hurricane Irma Damage – City Marina at Garrison Bight to Ebsary Foundation Company in the amount not to exceed \$168,500. And approving any necessary budget transfers.

BACKGROUND

In September 2017, Hurricane Irma skirted Key West to the East causing considerable damage to the City's marinas. The City Marina at Garrison Bight receive extensive damage to several piers. Tarpon Pier was damaged by a houseboat resting on top of it torquing the end of the main dock and t-pier.

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

ITB #18-037 was advertised on August 2, 2018 seeking bids from qualified individuals or firms for the hurricane damaged dock repair. Ebsary Foundation Company was the sole respondent on August 22, 2018:

Ebsary's bid was reviewed by Staff, determined to be responsive and within project cost estimate.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Project HU1701G09-5756300 is an unbudgeted expense due to Hurricane Irma damage. It is anticipated that the City be reimbursed by FEMA for this repair.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approving contract award for ITB #18-037 Tarpon Pier Repair – Hurricane Irma Damage – City Marina at Garrison Bight to Ebsary Foundation Company in the amount not to exceed \$168,500. And approving any necessary budget transfers.
