A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, SPONSORING A “CONCH HERITAGE DAY” TO CELEBRATE THE UNVEILING OF THE BISHOP KEE BRONZE STATUE ON SATURDAY, MARCH 7, 2015, BETWEEN 2:30 P.M. TO 4:30 P.M. AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF SOUTH STREET BETWEEN DUVAL AND THE SOUTHERNMOST POINT AND WHITEHEAD STREET FROM UNITED TO THE POINT ; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to sponsor a “Conch Heritage Day” to celebrate the unveiling of the Bishop Kee Statue at the Southernmost Point; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. Permission is granted for the street closure during the unveiling of the Bishop Kee Statue on Saturday, March 7, 2015, between 2:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. Streets will be closed from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. That the statue is an Art in Public Places project and event.

SECTION 3. That the event is also to celebrate the history of the Southernmost Point and the heritage of the surrounding community.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
