**RE:** Executive Summary – State Forfeiture donation to Wesley House Family Services

**Action:**

The Key West Police Department intends to donate \$3,000.00 from State Forfeiture Funds to Wesley House Family Services. This request complies with the requirements of Florida Statute Section 932.7055. This donation will help Wesley House Family Services in their crime prevention services and training.

**Background:**

Children in foster care are frequently the victims of crime. Their limited possession, often the only link to their past, are frequently unsecured. The older children need to secure their method of transportation, which is their lifeline to getting to school and work. Wesley House Family Services has a wide range of crime prevention services and are constantly incorporating enhancements to the program. These enhancements include additional training for the staff, who are in the forefront of the crisis and are entering a family's home for the first time.

The requested funds will come from the departments State Law Enforcement Officer Trust Fund (172-2111-521-8200),

Approve the request to donate \$3,000.00 to Wesley House Family Services.
