A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, RESCINDING THE APPROVAL GRANTED IN RESOLUTION NO. 15-291 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SEVEN (7) REMINGTON 12 GA. SHOTGUNS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,654,70, USING FUNDS FROM THE 2015 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL (JAG) ASSISTANCE GRANT JUSTICE SOLICITATION; AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF SIX (6) POLICE BICYCLES FROM iFORCE PATROL BICYCLES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$12,778.82, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(4)(b) BEST INTERESTS OF THE SECTION AND 2-844, BRAND SPECIFICATIONS, USING FUNDS FROM THE 2015 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) - LOCAL SOLICITATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 15-243, the City Commission accepted Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Grant funding in the amount of \$13,207.00; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 15-291 the City Commission approved the purchase of tactical shotguns, using a portion of the allocated Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Funds; and

WHEREAS, the vendor was unable to provide the specified shotguns, the order was cancelled, and the 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG funds remain available for use; and

WHEREAS, KWPD staff researched police bicycles and determined that iForce bicycles include features not available in other police bicycles, and recommends the approval of a brand name

specification purchase, pursuant to section 2-844(a) of the Code of Ordinances, and to section 2-797(4)(b), best interests of the City, with funds from the 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Resolution No. 15-291, which authorized the purchase of up to seven (7) shotguns by the Key West Police Department, using funds from the 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, in the amount of \$4,654.70, is hereby rescinded.

Section 2: That the City Commission approves and authorizes the purchase of six (6) police bicycles from iForce Patrol Bicycles pursuant to sections 2-844(a) and 2-797(4)(b) of the code of ordinances, in support of community policing objectives, using funds from the 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant, in the amount of \$12,778.82.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
