A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A \$500.00 DONATION FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TRUST FUND (STATE FORFEITURE FUNDS), PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTES SECTION 932.7055, TO THE BETHEL AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH TO BE USED FOR FACILITATING THE SUCCESS THROUGH EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM (STEP); PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Rev. Antonio Magwood, pastor of Bethel A.M.E. Church, has implemented and facilitated the STEP, in cooperation with the Department of Juvenile Justice and other local agencies, to empower local youth, including juvenile offenders and drug court offenders, by teaching positive decision making and life skills development, to help reduce recidivism; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That pursuant to Florida Statutes section 932.7055, a \$500.00 donation is hereby authorized by the City Commission from state forfeiture funds for use by the Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church to facilitate the Success

Through Empowerment Program, for the purposes expressly authorized by that statutory section.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
