RE: A Budget Amendment to allocate

Navy monies in the City budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

#### **ACTION STATEMENT:**

This resolution will approve the Amendment of the City budget for FY2012-2013 to account for US Navy equity in pooled cash and authorize the allocation of monies in cash account #602-0000-104.00-00 to the City Budget in Navy Reserves account #602-1900-519.98-06 in the amount of \$1,675,000. This action has no linkage to the May 2011 Strategic Plan.

# **BACKGROUND:**

Pursuant to ongoing City payments to Navy equity per the terms of the Mole Pier lease, revenues have accrued that are not currently accounted for in the FY2012-2013 budget. The purpose of this action is to amend the FY2012-2013 budget to account for all existing US Navy equity and the remaining projected revenues from the Mole Pier lease which expires on June 30, 2013.

Allocation of these monies to the Navy fund will allow necessary Budget Transfers and Purchase Order adjustments pursuant to relevant Commission approvals and City ordinances pertaining to procurement.

#### PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

This administrative action is in conformance with the Lease Agreement N62467-03-RP-00077 between the City and the U.S. Navy as approved by Resolution 03-138 and is necessary in order to perform Budget Transfers and adjustments to Purchase Orders for In-kind projects already underway.

# **OPTIONS:**

- 1. City Commission can approve this Budget Amendment.
- 2. City Commission could decline to approve and direct staff to perform additional analysis and provide additional justification.

# **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

Budget Amendment: Funds in the amount of \$1,675,000 will be allocated to the City Budget in the Navy Reserves Account #602-1900-519.98-06.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City Commission select option 1, approving this Budget Amendment.
