A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, GRANTING PURSUANT TO KEY WEST CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 10-16, AN EXCEPTION ALLOWING GLORIA KIMBERLY McGEE TO KEEP A TOTAL OF EIGHT DOGS AND FOUR CATS ON PREMISES AT THE RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 2812 FOGARTY AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West, section 10-16 states "No person may keep more than four domestic animals on any premises... However, exceptions to this requirement may be granted by the city commission, with any conditions deemed appropriate, for premises upon which are kept domestic animals of historical, social, or tourism significance..."; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the eight dogs and four cats, currently residing at Ms. McGee's premises are animals of social significance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That an exception to section 10-16 of the Key West Code of Ordinances is hereby granted for the eight dogs and four cats currently located at 2812 Fogarty Avenue, so long as the animals pose no significant health or safety hazard to themselves or to the citizens and visitors of the City of Key West.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
