A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE KEY WEST, CITY OF FLORIDA, OF AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT **SMOKE** TESTING/INFLOW & INFILTRATION TESTING SERVICES, FROM USSI, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$104,180.00, BY PIGGYBACKING ON A GOVERNMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN USSI, LLC AND THE TOHO WATER AUTHORITY BID #IFB-202-076, PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-797(3) AND SECTION 2-797(4)(b)OF THE CODE ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS: AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City's wastewater system and stormwater systems have experienced noticeably increased flow effects in recent years, especially as high tides get higher and remain for longer periods of time due to sea level rise; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends a thorough investigation into the cause of inflow and infiltration, using the services of USSI, which will perform smoke testing of the city's wastewater systems to identify deficiencies, and make repair recommendations; and

WHEREAS, section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances authorizes purchases pursuant to government contracts; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code Section 2-797(4)(b), the City Manager finds that exceptional circumstances exist to exempt a purchase from the competitive bid requirements in the best interests of the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the procurement of smoke testing/inflow and infiltration inspection from USSI, LLC, by piggybacking on the Toho Water Authority contract IFB 20-076, pursuant to City Code section 2-797(3) and 2-797(4)(b), in an amount not to exceed \$104,180.00 is hereby authorized.

Section 2: That funds for this project are budgeted in sewer/renewal and replacement/repairs and maintenance account No. 401-3503-535-4600. Any necessary budget adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to
execute any necessary documents, upon consent of the City
Attorney.
Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication
by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of
the Commission.
