-- Robert John Hermanson II Arrest Narrative:

On 11/4/2022, at approximately 1308 hours, I (Ofc Betz) was on bike patrol on the 400 block of Duval when I noticed a theft suspect ride passed me.

I caught up to the suspect, known to me as Robert Hermanson and asked if I could speak to him. I spoke to him about a theft which occurred on 11/1/2022 at Walgreens, 527 Duval St. Ofc Slaunwhite and I responded at which point I viewed a video of Hermanson stealing merchandise.

I explained to Hermanson that I would forward his identifying information to Ofc Slaunwhite who would complete the investigation.

Once I gathered his information, I asked Hermanson if he had anything illegal on him. He said he did not. I asked for consent to search. Hermanson granted consent. During a search of Hermanson`s back pack, I located a spoon with a white residue in it. The spoon also had burn marks on the bottom, consistent with the use of opioids. Hermanson initially said the spoon was used for eating yogurt in the morning, but when I pointed out the burn marks, he claimed he found it. Hermanson then claimed the residue was his yogurt. I continued searching Hermanson`s belongings. I located a baggie of a white powdery substance in his book bag. I attempted to detain Hermanson. Hermanson did not cooperate initially, but was eventually handcuffed. I had Hermanson take a seat on the curb as I continued to search his belongings.

Ofc Stevens arrived on scene. I searched the pockets of Hermanson`s rain jacket. I located a crack pipe in the right pocket. Hermanson immediately claimed the jacket did not belonging to him.

Ofc Stevens field tested the powder. The powder did not test positive for cocaine, methamphetamine nor heroin. Ofc Howell arrived on scene.

During the course of my investigation, Hermanson continued to get louder and more agitated. He was complaining that the theft he committed was a minor violation and that the spoon and crack pipe were insignificant since the powder did not test. Once Hermanson began using excessive profanities to the point he was disorderly, I asked Ofc Howell to place him into his patrol vehicle.

I field tested the residue on the spoon for Heroin. The field test showed a positive result. Ofc Stevens and I continued processing the property when Ofc Howell requested one of us assist him with Hermanson, who attempted to kick out his patrol car window. I walked to the car and assisted Ofc Howell with Hermanson. Hermanson complained his handcuffs were too tight. I directed Hermanson to face away from me so I could loosen them. Once the handcuffs were adjusted, I had Hermanson sit back in the car. Hermanson was very agitated and was screaming at Ofc Howell. Hermanson did not cooperate and tried to prevent me from placing him in the seatbelt. Hermanson continued to push against me as I tried to buckle the seatbelt. I pinned Hermanson to the rear of the seat, but had to release him to loosen slack in the seat belt to secure it. As I did, Ofc Howell reached over my shoulder and tried to hold Hermanson to the rear of the seat. I heard Ofc Howell yell at Hermanson to "don`t try to bite me."

During Hermanson`s struggles, he suffered a minor abrasion to his nose and the right side of his head. As Hermanson continued yelling at Howell, he unintentionally spit his blood on my left should, arm and face. I told Ofc Howell to get a wipe so I could clean the abrasion.

I called Sgt Duponty to the scene due to the minor abrasion suffered by Hermanson.

While waiting for Sgt Duponty, Ofc Howell advised Hermanson began spitting in the rear of his patrol car. Ofc Howell advised he donned a spit hood on Hermanson to prevent him from spitting on his car and on officers. Ofc Howell advised when Sgt Duponty arrived on scene, he went o speak to Hermanson. He advised when he opened the rear of the patrol vehicle, so Sgt Duponty could speak to him, Hermanson kicked open the door. Ofc Howell described Hermanson as less than cooperative during Sgt Duponty's interview. Ofc Howell advised when he stepped in to close the door after Sgt Duponty was finished, Hermanson kicked him in the center of his chest. Ofc Howell told me he had to physically move Hermanson into the patrol car so he could get the door closed. Ofc Howell added that when he did grab onto Hermanson, Hermanson attempted to bite him. Ofc Howell transported Hermanson to MCDC for processing. Ofc Stevens took custody of the crack pipe, burnt spoon and the white powder. Ofc Stevens placed the items into property as evidence.

There is BWC for this case.

Since Hermanson was in possession of a burnt spoon with FTP opioid residue, Hermanson was in violation of FSS 893.147-1.

Since Hermanson was in possession of a crack pipe, Hermanson was in violation of FSS 893.147-1.

Since Hermanson did attempt to defeat Ofc Howell's efforts at lawfully detaining him by kicking him in the chest and trying to bite him, Hermanson was in violation of FSS 833.01.

The white powder will be sent to the lab for analysis.

On Friday, 11/04/2022 at approximately 1308 hours, Ofc. Stevens and I (Ofc. Howell) responded to the 500-Block of Duval Street after Ofc. Betz requested additional assistance with a disorderly subject.

As I approached, I noticed an unknown white male subject seated on the curb already in handcuffs, near the entrance of 500 Duval Street (CVS). The subject was later identified as Robert J. Hermanson III (DOB: 11/11/1966, Arrestee). Hermanson became more and more agitated as Ofc. Betz and Ofc. Stevens searched his belongings. Hermanson eventually began screaming and yelling obscenities toward Ofc. Betz, Ofc. Stevens, and random passersby. Hermanson became so disruptive that Ofc. Betz requested that I place Hermanson in my patrol vehicle. As I picked Hermanson up, he immediately began attempting to pull away from me. As I began walking Hermanson to my patrol vehicle, he attempted to stop in the middle of Duval Street several times. I was finally able to persuade Hermanson to continue walking through pain compliance and placing him in modified transporter hold.

As we approached my patrol vehicle, Hermanson again became extremely noncompliant and attempted to push away from my patrol vehicle as I searched his person. Hermanson continuously screamed and yelled obscenities toward me. Hermanson continuously refused to move his legs inside my patrol vehicle, continuously kicking the door in an attempt to deter me from closing the door. Once inside my patrol vehicle, Hermanson continuously spit and kicked the plexiglass divider as well as the bars and glass of the door.

Ofc. Betz walked over to my patrol vehicle to attempt to calm Hermanson. Hermanson began complaining of the handcuffs being too tight. Ofc. Betz agreed to loosen the handcuffs. After Ofc. Betz loosened the handcuffs, Hermanson again refused to allow my patrol vehicle door to be closed. Ofc. Betz moved Hermanson closer to the plexiglass divider however, due to Hermanson struggling Ofc. Betz was unable to place Hermanson in the seat belt. I reached over Ofc. Betz to assist with Hermanson. Hermanson attempted to bite my hand several times. I initially placed my hand on Hermanson's shoulder but due to Hermanson struggling, my hand shifted to the area near his right ear. I was also attempting to control Hermanson's head to prohibit him from headbutting Ofc. Betz and biting my hand. Due to Hermanson struggling with Ofc. Betz and me, Hermanson received a small abrasion on his right temple and the right side of his nose. Hermanson began spitting blood on Ofc. Betz. Ofc. Betz and I cleaned up Hermanson's temple and nose, while calling for Sgt. Duponty. We were eventually able to secure my patrol vehicle door. Hermanson continuously spit blood in the rear seat and on the plexiglass divider of my patrol vehicle. I placed Hermanson in a protective spit hood to prevent further exposure.

Once Sgt. Duponty arrived on scene, Hermanson began screaming and yelling obscenities toward me. Hermanson refused to answer Sgt. Duponty's inquiries. Sgt. Duponty determined that Hermanson did not have further injuries. Again, Hermanson refused to allow my patrol vehicle door to be closed. I had to forcefully move Hermanson closer to

On November 4, 2022, I responded to 500 Duval St, Key West, Florida to assist Ofc Betz who was requesting back-up. Upon arrival, I saw a white male, later identified as Robert HERMANSON, sitting on the sidewalk in handcuffs. Ofc Betz was searching HERMANSON's belongings and he showed me a cellophane wrapper containing an unknown white powder, a metal spoon with white powdery residue and a scorched glass pipe that he had discovered. I offered to field-test the white powder and I field-tested it for cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine and fentanyl and all the test kits yielded negative results.

HERMANSON was becoming increasingly volatile and he was yelling profanities. When Ofc Howell arrived, Ofc Betz asked that he secure him in his patrol vehicle due to HERMANSON's behavior. Ofc Howell escorted HERMANSON to his vehicle which was parked on the 500 block of Fleming St. Shortly after, Ofc Howell requested assistance with HERMANSON, saying that HERMANSON was kicking at his window. Ofc Betz asked me to remain with the property and evidence and he walked to Ofc Howell to assist.

I secured the evidence in my police car and Ofc Betz asked Sgt Duponty to respond to the scene. Ofc Betz returned to me and asked me to inspect him for blood, as HERMANSON had got blood on his face and arms, which he had tried to remove. I did not see any blood on his skin. Ofc Betz, who was on his police bicycle, asked me to remain with HERMANSON's bicycle and property while he went to retrieve his police vehicle. When he returned, he consulted with Sgt Duponty and I assisted in securing HERMANSON's bicycle and property in Ofc Betz's vehicle.

I transported the drug evidence to the police station for packaging. I submitted an FDLE lab analysis request for the white powder. My body worn camera (BWC) was activated and recording during the investigation and the footage has been uploaded to the evidence server.
