WHEREAS, staff and the project engineer of record, CH2M Hill, reviewed the bids received and recommended acceptance of the lowest responsive bid, submitted by Lanzo Construction, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Lanzo Construction, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,485,580.00 is hereby awarded and the City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement in conformity with the bid documents, upon the advice and consent of the city attorney.

Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

ACTION STATEMENT:

This resolution will approve the low bid of \$1,485,580 from Lanzo Construction, Inc. to construct an emergency stormwater outfall pipeline and elevated generator platform and control panel. The bid includes a \$200,000 contingency allowance and \$25,000 permitting fee allowance. The resolution will also authorize additional project costs, additional grant revenue, and use of reserves to fund the project.

The City will be reimbursed for 75% of the costs of this project from FEMA

BACKGROUND:

With the approval of Task Order 1-09-STM (Resolution 09-083, April 7, 2009), CH2M Hill designed an emergency outfall system originating at the pump-assisted well located at the intersection of Patricia and Ashby Streets. This design was reviewed and approved by FEMA resulting in the obligation of Phase II funding for the construction of the approved project. The City Commission approved the Phase II grant for construction funding at its March 16, 2011 meeting. (Resolution 11-076)

The project entails the construction of an emergency discharge to the Atlantic Ocean consisting of a pipeline that will connect the existing Patricia and Ashby Pump Station and terminate at a new outfall structure at the end of Bertha St. A generator and elevated concrete platform will be located at the Ashby St./Patricia St. site. All stormwater will be treated with existing vortex sediment separator prior to discharging to the outfall. The emergency outfall

will only be utilized during tropical storm/hurricanes or during severe rain events where homes could be under immediate threat of flooding.

A public meeting was held on April 28th to discuss this improvement with the neighborhood, which was supported by a good majority of the residents. A team of CH2M Hill, Perez Engineering, City Staff and OMI will assist with construction inspection and engineering.

PURPOSE AND JUSTIFICATION

The Patricia/Ashby Drainage Project will provide protection against a 25 year rain event for 50 years for approximately 30 homes. The benefit-to-cost ratio is over 2.0 saving the taxpayer an estimated \$4,000,000 for a \$2,000,000 lifecycle cost (including maintenance). Adjacent neighborhoods will also benefit from this project. Improved drainage in this Patricia/Ashby basin will help lessen the duration of flooding in some of the surrounding areas.

The City is seeking to proceed with the project in a timely manner. We need to finish the outfall pipeline work on Bertha and Atlantic Blvd. prior to FDOT initiating their paving project on South Roosevelt in April, 2012.

On July 13, 2011 the City opened the bids for this project. Lanzo Construction was the low-bidder at \$1,485,580 (including a \$200,000 contingency allowance and a \$25,000 permitting allowance). City Staff and the Engineer of Record (CH2M Hill) reviewed the bids and are recommending Lanzo Construction's bid be awarded. A budget transfer is needed to proceed with the project, which is detailed in the "Financial Impact" section below.

OPTIONS / ADVANTAGES / DISADVANTAGES:

- 1. The City Commission can award the low bid of Lanzo Construction, Inc., execute the budget transfers, and proceed with the project. This option will allow the City to construct a new project that could greatly assist the drainage in major storms for this frequently-flooded neighborhood, and enable the City to utilize significant funding assistance from FEMA. This project also will create a new emergency ocean outfall, which has been a permit that has been typically very difficult to secure from the Army Corps of Engineers and South Florida Water Management District.
- 2. The City Commission can decline the low bid from Lanzo Construction. This option is not recommended because we would not capitalize on this unique opportunity to construct a drainage project that would be of great benefit to this neighborhood which flooded in the most recent October storms, along with several occasions during the hurricane season of 2005. Without the funding assistance of FEMA, the City would have a very difficult time paying for the project ourselves in the future. Staff has no reason to believe that re-bidding the project would result in a lower cost to the City.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

FEMA will be covering 75% of the construction and construction administration costs of this

project. The total funding breakdown for this entire construction project would be as follows:

The City share includes a \$200,000 contingency allowance in the construction contract, and a \$25,000 allowance for permitting. Use of both allowances would not be initially reimbursable. However, at the conclusion of the project, use of contingency related to the original project scope of work can be submitted to FEMA for possible funding at the 75% rate. This of course would decrease the City's share of the project. Any unused contingency allowance funds at the end of the project would also decrease the City's contributed share.

In order to proceed with the project, the City will need to transfer \$319,312 from reserves to fund its share. There is sufficient funding level in reserves to move forward on this project (budget account 402-3801-538-98). In fact, the City had already included this higher cost in our FY 2012 rate model calculation that was part of our budget presentation to the Commission.

The overall project budget will increase \$691,957. This is due to the fact that the initial construction estimate was several years old, and some new components were added to improve the overall project. We will also amend the budget to account for an additional \$372,645 from the FEMA grant. At the City's request, FEMA will be funding 75% of the construction engineering and project management costs (in addition to construction), which was not part of the original agreement.

This project will be charged to account number 402-3802-538-65/ST0803.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Commission select option 1, awarding the low-bid to Lanzo Construction in the amount of \$1,485,580 for the Patricia and Ashby St. outfall project, and approving the budget transfers to proceed.

Three (3) bids were received for the subject contract on July 13, 2011 and are summarized in the attached Bid Results Summary table. All three (3) bids included a signed proposal and all the required forms.

The apparent low bidder, Lanzo Construction Company, has recent construction experience working on similar projects in the Florida Keys, and has also worked on similar projects throughout Florida with good references. Additionally, Lanzo completed the original construction of the Patricia & Ashby pump station in 2003.

We therefore recommend that the City award the Patricia & Ashby Emergency Outfall contract to Lanzo Construction Company, in the amount of \$1,485,580. This bid is higher than the 2009 engineer's estimate, due to the age of the estimate and additional construction items included in the final bid package.

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the City of Key West Patricia and Ashby Streets Stormwater Emergency Outfall, addressed to the City of Key West, will be received at the Office of the City Clerk, City of Key West, 525 Angela St., Key West Florida, 33040 until 3:00 p.m., local time, July 13, 2011 and then will be publicly opened and read. Any bids received after the time and date specified will not be considered.

The project proposes improvements to the City of Key West, Florida drainage system to reduce flooding and pre-treat stormwater runoff. The project consists of the installation of an emergency generator with concrete platform, associated electrical and I&C, approximately 1,915 linear feet of 30-inch outfall to the ocean, and all related work and appurtenances.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by bid security as prescribed in the Instructions to Bidders, payable to the City of Key West, Florida, in an amount not less than (5) five percent of the amount of the bid. The contractor shall be a licensed contractor by the State of Florida and submit proof of such with the bid.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish the necessary additional bond(s) for the faithful performance of the Contract, as prescribed in the Bidding Documents. The Bidder will also be required to furnish documentation showing that he is in compliance with the licensing requirements of the State and the provisions of Chapter 66 section 87 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West. THE BIDDER MUST BE A LICENSED CONTRACTOR BY THE STATE OF FLORIDA AND SUBMIT PROOF OF SUCH WITH THE BID.

The Bidder shall furnish documentation showing that he is in compliance with the licensing requirements of the provisions of Chapter 66 Section 87 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Key West; within 10 days the following the Notice of Award.

All bid bonds, contract bonds, insurance contracts, and certificates of insurance shall be either executed by or countersigned by a licensed resident agent of the Surety or Insurance Company having his place of business in the State of Florida, and in all ways complying with the insurance laws of the State of Florida. Further, the said Surety or Insurance Company shall be duly licensed and qualified to do business in the State of Florida.

Before a Contract will be awarded for the work contemplated herein, the CITY will conduct such investigation as is necessary to determine the performance record and ability of the apparent low Bidder to perform the size and type of work specified under this Contract. Upon request, the Bidder shall submit such information as deemed necessary by the CITY to evaluate the Bidder's qualifications.

For information concerning the proposed work, or for appointment to visit the site of the proposed work, contact the designated Engineer by the General Services and Utilities Department of the City of Key West.

As stated above at the time of the bid submittal the Bidder must provide satisfactory documentation of State Licenses. The Bidder shall furnish documentation showing that he is in compliance with the licensing requirements of County, and City licenses as would be required within ten days of the award. The successful Bidder must also be able to satisfy the City Attorney as to such insurance coverage and legal requirements as may be demanded by the Bid in question.

The City may reject bids for any and/or all of the following reasons: (1) for budgetary reasons, (2) if the bidder misstates or conceals a material fact in its bid, (3) if the bid does not strictly conform to the law or is non-responsive to the bid requirements, (4) if the bid is conditional, or (5) if a change of circumstances occurs making the purpose of the bid unnecessary to the City. The City may also waive any minor formalities or irregularities in any bid, (6) if such rejection is in the best interest of the City. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

A. <u>FORMAT</u>

The Contract Documents are divided into parts, divisions, and sections for convenient organization and reference. Generally, there has been no attempt to divide the Specification sections into work performed by the various building trades, work by separate subcontractors, or work required for separate facilities in the Project.

B. DOCUMENT INTERPRETATION

The separate sections contained within these Contract Documents are intended to be mutually cooperative and to provide all details reasonably required for the execution of the proposed work.

Should there be any doubt as to the meaning or intent of said Contract Documents, the Bidder should request of the Engineer, in writing (at least 6 working days prior to bid opening) an interpretation thereof. Any interpretation or change in said Contract Documents will be made only in writing, in the form of Addenda to the Documents which will be furnished to all registered holders of Contract Documents. Bidders shall submit with their Bid, or indicate receipt of, all Addenda. The Owner will not be responsible for any other explanation or interpretations of said Documents.

C. DRAWINGS

Details of construction are bound separately.

2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

A general description of the work to be done is contained in the Invitation to Bid. The scope is specified in applicable parts of these Contract Documents.

3. OUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS

The prospective Bidders must meet the statutorily prescribed requirements before award of Contract by the Owner.

Bidders must hold or obtain all licenses or certificates required by federal, state, or local statutes, or regulations in order to bid and perform the work specified herein.

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4. <u>BIDDER'S UNDERSTANDING</u>

Each Bidder must inform himself of the conditions relating to the execution of the work, and it is assumed that he will inspect the site and make himself thoroughly familiar with all the Contract Documents. Failure to do so will not relieve the successful Bidder of his obligation to enter into a Contract and complete the contemplated work in strict accordance with the Contract Documents. It shall be the Bidder's obligation to verify for himself and to his complete satisfaction all information concerning site and subsurface conditions.

The Owner will make available to prospective Bidders upon request and at the office of the Engineer, prior to bid opening, any information that he may have as to subsurface conditions and surface topography at the worksite.

Information derived from inspection of topographic maps, or from Drawings showing location of utilities and structures will not in any way relieve the Contractor from any risk, or from properly examining the Site and making such additional investigations as he may elect, or from properly fulfilling all the terms of the Contract Documents.

Each Bidder shall inform himself of, and the Bidder awarded a Contract shall comply with, federal, state, and local laws, statutes, and ordinances relative to the execution of the work. This requirement includes, but is not limited to, applicable regulations concerning minimum wage rates, nondiscrimination in the employment of labor, protection of public and employee safety and health, environmental protection, the protection of natural resources, fire protection, burning and nonburning requirements, permits, fees, and similar subjects.

TYPE OF PROPOSAL

A. UNIT PRICE

Bidders shall submit a Bid on a unit price basis for each item of Work listed in the Bid schedule.

The total of all Bid unit prices will be the sum of the products of the estimated quantity of each item and the corresponding unit price. The final quantities and Contract Price will be determined in accordance with Paragraph 11.03 of the General Conditions.

Discrepancies between the multiplication of units of Work and unit prices will be resolved in favor of the unit prices. Discrepancies between the indicated sum of any column of figures and the correct sum thereof will be resolved in favor of the correct sum.

Units of measure shown on Bid Form shall have the meanings as described in Section 01 29 00, Payment Procedures.

6. PREPARATION OF PROPOSALS

A. GENERAL

All blank spaces in the Bid form must be filled in for all schedules and associated parts, as required, preferably in BLACK ink. All price information shall be clearly shown in figures where required. No changes shall be made in the phraseology of the forms. In case of discrepancy between unit prices and extended totals, unit prices shall prevail.

Any Bid shall be deemed informal which contains omissions, erasures, alterations, or additions of any kind, or prices uncalled for, or in which any of the prices are obviously unbalanced, or which in any manner shall fail to conform to the conditions of the published Invitation to Bid.

Only one Bid from any individual, firm, partnership, or corporation, under the same or different names, will be considered. Should it appear to the Owner that any Bidder is interested in more than one Bid for work contemplated, all Bids in which such Bidder is interested will be rejected.

B. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIERS

The manufacturer name, trade name, brand name, or catalog number used in the Specifications is for the purpose of describing and establishing equipment that has been presented for this Project. Other equipment will not be accepted.

C. SIGNATURE

The Bidder shall sign his Bid in the blank space provided therefore. If Bidder is a corporation, the legal name of the corporation shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the officer or officers authorized to sign Contracts on behalf of the corporation. If Bidder is a partnership, the true name of the firm shall be set forth above, together with the signature of the partner or partners authorized to sign Contracts in behalf of the partnership. If signature is by an agent, other than an officer of a corporation or a member of a partnership, a notarized power-of-attorney must be on file with the Owner prior to opening of Bids or submitted with the Bid, otherwise the Bid will be regarded as not properly authorized.

D. SPECIAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

The Bidder's attention is brought to the hiring practices and licenses and permits of the City of Key West. These are defined in the addition to Article 6.08, "Permits" and Article 6:09, "Laws and Regulations" as set forth in the Supplementary Conditions.

F. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIMES

A person or affiliate who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid on a contract to provide any goods or services to a public entity, may not submit a bid on a contract with a public entity for the construction or repair of a public building or public work, may not submit bids on leases of real property to a public entity, may not be awarded or perform work as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with any public entity and may not transact business with any public entity in excess of the threshold amount provided in Section 287.017, for CATEGORY TWO for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list."

G. CITY OF KEY WEST LICENSE REQUIRED

Contractor is required to have a Certified or registered Electrical Contractors City of Key West license and a Certified or Registered General Contractors City of Key West license. License fees not to exceed \$350.00.

H. ANTI-KICKBACK AFFIDAVIT

The Bidder shall submit a signed and notarized Anti-Kickback Affidavit with Bid on the form provided herein.

I. FLORIDA TRENCH SAFETY ACT

The Bidders attention is directed to the enactment of the Florida Trench Safety Act which incorporates OSHA Standards 29CFRs 1926.650, Subpart P, as the state's trench excavation safety standards. The Bidder shall list separately, in the Bid, the cost of compliance with these standards on a linear footage basis and the method of compliance. The Bidder shall determine if special shoring requirements are needed. Special shoring shall be identified in the Bid. The successful Bidder is fully responsible for the design of the trench safety system and the compliance with the applicable standards for the project.

7. STATE AND LOCAL SALES AND USE TAXES

Unless the Supplementary Conditions contains a statement that the Owner is exempt from state sales tax on materials incorporated into the work due to the qualification of the work under this Contract, all state and local sales and use taxes, as required by the laws and statutes of the state and its political subdivisions, shall be paid by the Contractor. Prices quoted in the Bid shall include all nonexempt sales and use taxes, unless provision is made in the Bid form to separately itemize the tax.

LOCAL PREFERENCE

City of Key West policy of local preference is applied to bids submitted by qualified local business. Local preference is 5 percent of quoted bidder or \$1,000.00, whichever is less.

9. SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

All Bids must be submitted not later than the time prescribed, at the place, and in the manner set forth in the Invitation to Bid. Bids must be made on the Bid forms provided herewith. The Bidder shall submit two (2) originals and FOUR (4) ELECTRONIC COPIES ON DISC or USB DRIVES WITH A SINGLE PDF FILE OF THE FULL PROPOSAL and all required bonds, attachments, and forms.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS 00 21 13 - 5

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Each Bid must be submitted in two sealed envelope one within the other, so marked as to indicate the Bidder's name and its contents without being opened, and addressed in conformance with the instructions in the Invitation to Bid.

10. MODIFICATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF PROPOSALS

Prior to the time and date designated for receipt of Bids, any Bid submitted may be withdrawn by notice to the party receiving Bids at the place designated for receipt of Bids. Such notice shall be in writing over the signature of the Bidder or by telegram. If by telegram, written confirmation over the signature of the Bidder shall be mailed and postmarked on or before the date and time set for receipt of Bids. No Bid may be withdrawn after the time scheduled for opening of Bids, unless the time specified in paragraph Award of Contract of these Instructions to Bidders shall have elapsed.

11. BID SECURITY

Bids must be accompanied by cash, a certified check, or cashier's check drawn on a bank in good standing, or a bid bond issued by a Surety authorized to issue such bonds in the state where the work is located, in the amount of 5 percent of the total amount of the Bid submitted. This bid security shall be given as a guarantee that the Bidder will not withdraw his Bid for a period of 60 days after bid opening, and that if awarded the Contract, the successful Bidder will execute the attached Contract and furnish properly executed Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the full amount of the Contract price within the time specified.

The Attorney-in-Fact who executes this bond in behalf of the Surety must attach a notarized copy of his power-of-attorney as evidence of his authority to bind the Surety on the date of execution of the bond. Where State Statute requires, certification by a resident agent shall also be provided.

If the Bidder elects to furnish a Bid Bond, he shall use the Bid Bond form bound herewith, or one conforming substantially thereto in form and content.

12. RETURN OF BID SECURITY

Within 15 days after the award of the Contract, the Owner will return the bid securities to all Bidders whose Bids are not to be further considered in awarding the Contract. Retained bid securities will be held until the Contract has been finally executed, after which all bid securities, other than Bidders' bonds and any guarantees which have been forfeited, will be returned to the respective Bidders whose Bids they accompanied.

13. AWARD OF CONTRACT

The award will be made under one Contract by the Owner on the basis of the Bid from the lowest, responsive, responsible Bidder. The Owner may award entire Bid or selected line items based on the City's best interest and available funds at time of Award.

Within 60 calendar days after the opening of Bids, the Owner will accept one of the Bids or will act in accordance with the following paragraphs. The acceptance of the Bid will be by written notice of award, mailed to the office designated in the Bid, or delivered to the Bidder's representative. In the event of failure of the lowest responsive, responsible Bidder to sign the Contract and provide an acceptable Performance Bond, Payment Bond, insurance certificate(s) and evidence of holding required licenses and certificates, the Owner may award the Contract to the next lowest responsive, responsible Bidder. Such award, if made, will be made within 75 days after the opening of Bids.

The Owner reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Bids, and to waive any informalities and irregularities in said Bids.

14. EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

The successful Bidder shall, within 10 working days after receiving Notice of Award, sign and deliver to the Owner a Contract in the form hereto attached, together with the insurance certificate examples of the bonds as required in the Contract Documents and evidence of holding required licenses and certificates. Within 10 working days after receiving the signed Contract from the successful Bidder, the Owner's authorized agent will sign the Contract. Signature by both parties constitutes execution of the Contract.

CONTRACT BONDS

A. PERFORMANCE AND PAYMENT BONDS

The successful Bidder shall file with the Owner, at the time of delivery of the signed Contract, a Performance Bond and Payment Bond on the form bound herewith, each in the full amount of the Contract price in accordance with the requirements of Florida Statutes Section 255.05 or 713.23, as applicable, as security for the faithful performance of the Contract and the payment of all persons supplying labor and materials for the construction of the work, and to cover all guarantees against defective workmanship or materials, or both, during the warranty period following the date of final acceptance of the work by the Owner. The Surety furnishing this bond shall have a sound financial standing and a record of service satisfactory to the Owner, shall be authorized to do business in the State of Florida, and shall be listed on the current U.S. Department of Treasury Circular Number 570, or amendments thereto in the Federal Register, of acceptable Sureties for federal projects.

B. POWER-OF-ATTORNEY

The Attorney-in-Fact (Resident Agent in state which work is being performed) who executes this Performance and Payment Bond in behalf of the Surety must attach a notarized copy of his power-of-attorney as evidence of his authority to bind the Surety on the date of execution of the bond.

All Contracts, Performance and Payment Bonds, and respective powers-of-attorney will have the same date.

16. FAILURE TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AND FURNISH BOND

The Bidder who has a Contract awarded to him and who fails to promptly and properly execute the Contract or furnish the required Bonds shall forfeit the bid security that accompanied his bid, and the bid security shall be retained as liquidated damages by the Owner, and it is agreed that this said sum is a fair estimate of the amount of damages the Owner will sustain in case the Bidder fails to enter into a Contract or furnish the required Bonds. Bid security deposited in the form of cash, a certified check, or cashier's check shall be subject to the same requirement as a Bid Bond.

17. PERFORMANCE OF WORK BY CONTRACTOR

The Contractor shall perform on the site and with his own organization, labor equivalent to at least 40 percent of the total amount of the work to be performed under this Contract and materials. If, during the progress of the work hereunder, the Contractor requests a reduction of such percentage, and the Engineer determines that it would be to the client's advantage, the percentage of the labor required to be performed by the Contractor's own organization may be reduced; PROVIDED prior written approval of such reduction is obtained by the contractor from the Engineer.

Each Bidder must furnish with his Bid a list of the items that he will perform with his own forces and the estimated total cost of these items.

18. TIME OF COMPLETION

The time of completion of the work to be performed under this Contract is the essence of the Contract. Delays and extensions of time may be allowed in accordance with the provisions stated in the General Conditions. The time allowed for the completion of the work authorized is stated in the Bid.

19. MANDATORY PRE-BID CONFERENCE

A mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held by the City of Key West on June 27, 2011. The meeting will take place at Old City Hall, 2nd Floor, 510 Greene Street, Key West beginning at 1:00 p.m. The City of Key West requires attendance by all prospective bidders. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss particular requirements and answer questions of the prospective bidders relative to completing this project. Bids from bidders that do not attend this Pre-bid Conference will be considered non-responsive and not accepted for consideration of this work by the City of Key West.

CERTIFICATES OF INSURANCE

Bidder agrees to furnish the Owner, before commencing the Work under this Contract, the certificates of insurance as specified in these Documents.

START OF CONSTRUCTION AND CONTRACT COMPLETION TIMES

The Bidder agrees to begin work within 10 calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed and to achieve Substantial Completion within 240 calendar days from the date when the Contract Times commence to run as provided in paragraph 2.03. A of the General Conditions, and Work will be completed and ready for final payment and acceptance in accordance with paragraph 14.07 of the General Conditions within 270 calendar days from the date when the Contract Times commence to run.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In the event the Bidder is awarded the Contract, Owner and Bidder recognize that time is of the essence of this Agreement and that Owner will suffer financial loss if the Work is not completed within the times specified in paragraph Start of Construction and Contract Completion Times above, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with Article 12 of the General Conditions. Owner and Bidder also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving in a legal or other dispute resolution proceeding the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Bidder agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty) Bidder shall pay Owner \$3,000.00 per day for each day that expires after the time specified for substantial completion.

After Substantial Completion, if Bidder neglects, refuses, or fails to complete the remaining Work within the Contract Times or any Owner-granted extension thereof, Bidder shall pay Owner \$1,000.00 for each day that expires after the time specified in paragraph Start of Construction and Contract Completion Times, above for completion and readiness for final payment. Liquidated damages shall run concurrent.

Owner will recover such liquidated damages by deducting the amount owed from the final payment or any retainage held by Owner.

ADDENDA

The Bidder hereby acknowledges that he has received Addenda No's. 1, 2, —, —, (Bidder shall insert No. of each Addendum received) and agrees that all addenda issued are hereby made part of the Contract Documents, and the Bidder further agrees that his Bid(s) includes all impacts resulting from said addenda.

The Bidder agrees that the amounts for both unit price and lump sum work represent a true measure of labor and materials required to perform the Work, including all allowances for overhead and profit for each type of work called for in these Contract Documents. The amounts shall be shown in both words and figures. In case of discrepancy, the amount shown in words shall govern.

UNIT PRICE SCHEDULE

Unit prices have been computed in accordance with Paragraph 11.03.C of the General Conditions and Section 01 29 00, Payment Procedures, Paragraph 1.06.

CONTINGENCY ALLOWANCE

Bidder further agrees that the amount shown is an estimated amount to be included in the Total Base Bid for unforeseen conditions and conflicts. Bidder further acknowledges that payment will be based on actual costs as determined in conformance with the Contract Documents and as authorized by Change Order. The Owner will negotiate with the Contractor how each Contingency Allowance will be spent prior to performing the work.

BUILDING PERMIT ALLOWANCE

Bidder further acknowledges that this amount shows is an estimated amount to be included in the Total Base Bid for the Building Permit required by the City of Key West. Bidder acknowledges that payment will be based on actual costs for the permit(s).

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Bidder acknowledges that estimated quantities are not guaranteed and are solely for the purpose of comparison of Bids, and final payment for all Unit Prices Bid items will be based on actual quantities, determined as provided in the Contract Documents.


