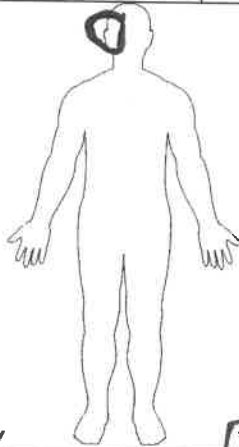

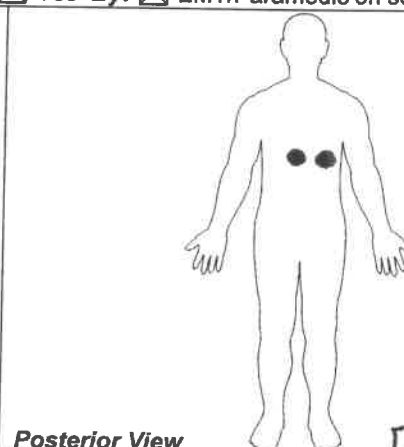

35. Anterior View





Posterior View

On 08/12/19, around 2347 hours, I (Ofc. Jackson) and Ofc. Mogerley were dispatched to the corner of Eaton St. and Duval St. to assist MCSO Sgt. David Lariz with a verbal dispute.

On arrival we met the Sgt. Lariz and Involved party Jennifer Sayko. Sgt. Lariz told us that Sayko and her boyfriend (Identified as Stephen Gunnell) were arguing. Sgt. Lariz handed me both their Florida Driver licenses.

Ofc. Mogerley went to talk to Gunnell. I ran a warrant check with Key West Police Dispatch on both subjects, and both came back cleared. Ofc. Mogerley and Ofc. Brabc went to talk to Sayko. Sayko was calling for an Uber when Gunnell got up and started to walk away. Gunnell was cussing very loud. Ofc. Mogerley walked up to him and asked him to sit down. Gunnell was cussing at Ofc. Mogerley and would not listen to Ofc. Mogerley. Gunnell walked up to Ofc. Mogerley. Ofc. Mogerley told Gunnell to sit down and Gunnell walked into Ofc. Mogerley, and Ofc. Mogerley had his hand up to prevent him from getting closer. Gunnell said "Fuck off", and did not listen to Ofc. Mogerley who told him to sit down several times. Gunnell said "You want to go" and pushed Ofc. Mogerley, and grabbed Ofc. Mogerley's arm and pushed/striking him in an attempt to get away. I tried to grab Gunnell's arm, but he pulled it away. Ofc. Mogerley pushed Gunnell away from him and he pulled his Taser and pointed it at Gunnell. Ofc. Mogerley told him to put his arms behind his back. Gunnell pushed Ofc. Mogerley's arm and Taser away. Ofc. Brabc grabbed Gunnell's left arm as he stood up and was pulling from him. Ofc. Mogerley tased Gunnell in the back and Gunnell fell to the ground and was still resisting. Ofc. Mogerley held the taser and gave him commands. Ofc. Brabc and I placed him into handcuffs. My BWC was knocked off during the incident.

I pulled out the taser prongs and placed them in the empty taser cartridge.

Gunnell tried to get up several times and was told to stay on the ground. Gunnell was evaluated by Key West Fire and Rescue. Rescue transported Gunnell to Lower Keys Hospital. After the Hospital released Gunnell, Ofc. Mogerley and I transported him to Monroe County Correctional Center.

On 8/12/2019 Stephen Gunnell committed the offense of Resisting Officer with Violence by pushing, striking, grabbing and pulling his arms away from Officers while trying to be handcuffed. This is a violation of Florida State Statute 843.01, Resisting Officer with Violence.

On 8/12/2018 Stephen Gunnell committed the offense of Battery on Law Enforcement Officer by pushing, striking, and grabbing Officers while being handcuffed. This is a violation of Florida State Statute, 784.07, Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer.

On 8/12/2019, at about 23:47 hours, Ofc. Jackson and I (Ofc. Mogerley), responded to the area of Eaton Street and Duval Street in the City of Key West to assist Monroe County Sheriff Deputy Sgt. D. Lariz who was out with a verbal dispute. Ofc. Jackson was on Field Training with me and I was his Field Training Officer.

Upon arrival we met with Sgt. D. Lariz who had the two identified as Jennifer Sayko (dob:12/28/1983), and Stephen Gunnell (dob:04/14/1967). Ofc. Jackson ran the driver's licenses with Key West Police Dispatch. Sgt. D. Lariz said that Gunnell was very intoxicated and the two were getting into verbal arguments. Gunnell was sitting against the concrete wall on Eaton Street across from Subway. Sayko said that they have had prior arguments and he pushed her once a long time ago.

I walked up to Gunnell, and he had started a verbal argument with a male and female on a scooter. The Scooter drove away as I walked up. I spoke with Gunnell and he seemed very intoxicated. He was repeating himself and swaying while seated. Gunnell had a strong odor of intoxicants (alcoholic beverage), along with bloodshot watery eyes. Gunnell had mood changes from being angry to being calm. He kept repeating something about driving.

I went to talk with Sayko to see if she felt safe with and could safely take Gunnell back to the hotel room. While speaking with Sayko, Gunnell started yelling and was screaming obscenities. Gunnell had stood up and started walking away. I told Gunnell to sit down back down and he said no. I went over to Gunnell told him to sit down and pointed at the concrete wall he was sitting on prior. Gunnell had his arm up and was walking right at me. I put my right hand up with an open palm, and Gunnell kept walking into me and did not stop. I gently pushed him back away from he and gave him another loud verbal command to sit down. Gunnell told me to "fuck off". Gunnell grabbed my right wrist and arm and started pushing me and said "you wanna go with me" and pushed me. When he grabbed my arm he struck it with his hand at the same time. I felt the strike hit my arm. I Pushed him back and created distance and pulled my Taser. Ofc. Jackson grabbed his left side to sit him down. I told Gunnell to put his arms behind his back and he pushed my hand and Taser away. Gunnell said "get the fuck off of me". Ofc. Brable grabbed his left arm as Gunnell got up, and Gunnell was pulling away from Ofc. Brable and resisting him. Gunnell was resisting all Officers by pulling his arms away and pushing us. Gunnell ignored all verbal commands. I aimed my Taser at Gunnell's back and fired it. The probes hit his upper middle back area. The Taser did not effect Gunnell and did not cause neuro muscular incapacitation (NMI). I put the Taser to his lower leg and it created NMI, as the probes were still in his back. Gunnell fell to his side, and was still resisting Officers. I gave Verbal commands to Gunnell to put his arms behind his back. I held the Taser against his leg to gain control of Gunnell. Gunnell now complied, and Ofc. Brable and Ofc. Jackson put Gunnell into handcuffs.

I requested Key West Rescue and Sgt. D. Kouri to respond. Ofc. Jackson pulled the Taser probes out of Gunnell's

back, and they were later placed into evidence at the Key West Police Dept. The probes were in Gunnell's upper middle back and had about a three inch spread. Ofc. Dehanas took photos of where he was tased.

Key West Rescue transported Gunnell to the Lower Keys Medical Center. Ofc. Brable rode with Rescue in the back of the ambulance. Ofc. Jackson and I followed them to the Lower Keys Medical Center. Gunnell told ER staff that he has a prior history for high blood pressure. Gunnell was released from Lower Keys Medical Center and Ofc. Jackson and I transported Gunnell to the Monroe County Correctional Center where he was processed on charges of battery on a law enforcement officer and resisting with violence.

Ofc. Jackson completed the case and arrest form.

The incident was recorded on my BWC and downloaded.

On Monday 08/12/2019, at approximetaly 2300 hours, I (Officer M. Brablc) responded to a verbal disturbace call at 425 Eaton St., Key West, FL.

KWPD dispatch advised, MCSO Sgt. David Lariz, was out with a couple arguing at that location.

Upon arrival the parties were separated and no longer arguing. Officer N. Mogerley was talking to the male subject (later identified as Stephen Gunnell) and Officer M. Jackson was with the female subject (later identified as Jennifer Sayko).

Gunnell was highly intoxicated and kept yelling at Sayko not to drive. Sayko told us they did not drive, and their vehicle is at the Hyatt Centric Hotel where the two were staying. Sayko said she will call an Uber for her and Gunnell to get back to the hotel.

Gunnell became upset and got up and started yelling at Sayko again. Officer N. Mogerley told Gunnell to stay quiet and to sit down. Gunnell made couple of steps towards Officer N. Mogerley. Officer Mogerley put his hand on Gunnell`s left shoulder and told him to sit back down. Gunnell pushed Officer N. Mogerley away. At that time, I was about 30 feet away from Gunnell and Officer N. Mogerley. I ran over to assist Officer N. Mogerley and grabbed Gunnell`s left arm. Gunnell attempted to pull away from us and Officer N. Mogerley utilized his Axon Taser to prevent Gunnell from pulling away from us. Gunnell went down to the ground and Officer M. Jackson and myself placed Gunnell in handcuffs. Gunnell continued to resist and I had to hold him down until EMS arrived.

Gunnell was transported to the Lower Keys Medical Center. I rode in the ambulance with Gunnell and Officer N. Mogerley and Officer M. Jackson followed in their patrol vehicle.

Gunnell was medically cleared and transported to MCDC.

My Axon BWC was activated.
