A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE PLAN AND A TIMELINE FOR THE POSSIBLE RELOCATION OF KOTS TO THE CITY OWNED FORMER EASTER SEALS PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City, in conjunction with its partners, currently provides a temporary overnight emergency shelter on County owned land on Stock Island ("KOTS"); and

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to relocate KOTS to property it owns on College Road in Stock Island that was formerly occupied by Easter Seals;

WHEREAS, such use is presently as of right in the zoning district; however changes are pending to the PS zoning district that would make relocation of the facility a conditional use subject to ample public input and a specified process;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is directed to give the City Commission a preliminary report on the feasibility and timeline of any relocation of KOTS, along with an initial plan which shall include a description of facilities, estimated costs and the

permissible number of occupants. Such report shall be made at or				
before the June 5, 2012 City Commission meeting.
