



Narrative

NARRATIVE OF INCIDENT
On December 19, 2025, Ofc. Sonnichsen was conducting a routine check of Higgs Beach when he observed Goodwin asleep and camping in the sand. Goodwin was asked to exit the beach and initially complied. Ofc. Sonnichsen ran Goodwin over Channel Two as they walked towards the roadway. Just before reaching the sidewalk, Goodwin stated he was not going to leave and sat down in an act of defiance. While awaiting dispatch to return Goodwin's history, Goodwin began to belligerently argue that it was his "right as a human being" to camp on the beach. He was subsequently secured in handcuffs and placed under arrest for camping and resisting without violence. Once in handcuffs, Goodwin continued to resist by aggressively pulling away from Ofc. Sonnichsen and shouting in close proximity to his face. Goodwin was taken to the ground in a controlled manner to limit his movements. He was assisted to his feet once compliant. Goodwin and Officer Sonnichsen did not sustain any injuries during this incident.
