Any task requested by the event officials and not previously listed will be charged on a time and materials basis. The standard cost of a six person crew for one hour with transportation is \$162.47.

The aforementioned tasks and costs are not synonymous with the event venue. These items are considered additional incurred costs. The city will provide written quotes that must be approved by authorized event purchasing officials. Historically, the powerboat event officials have requested additional outer mole cleaning (Item 4) and boat ramp cleaning during the scheduled special event period.
