A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A TASK ORDER UNDER THE CITY'S GENERAL UTILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE CONTRACT WITH CHARLEY TOPPINO & SONS, INC. IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$106,819.39 FOR AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) COMPLIANT SIDEWALK ON 19th STREET FROM DUCK AVENUE TO FLAGLER AVENUE; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CIY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 21-125, the City Commission approved a three-year General Utilities and Infrastructure Services contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends approval of a Task Order to construct/improve ADA sidewalks, driveway cuts and ramps along 19th Street between Duck Avenue and Flagler Avenue; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached Task Order under the City's General Utilities and Infrastructure Contract with Charley Toppino & Sons, Inc. in a total amount not to exceed \$106,8191.39, for ADA Compliant Sidewalk on 19th Street from Duck Avenue to Flagler Avenue, is hereby approved.

Section 2: That funding is budgeted for right of way improvements in account 102-4102-541-6300, Project Number

II41022101, for ADA sidewalks. Any necessary budget transfers or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute any necessary documents for this project, upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

Subject: **Approval of a task order proposal to Charlie Toppino and Sons (CTS) in the amount of \$106,819.39 for an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant Sidewalk on 19th Street from Duck Avenue to Flagler Avenue.**

Action Statement:

Authorize the City Manager to approve a task order proposal in the amount of \$106,819.39 to CTS for the construction of a new sidewalk and curb ramps along the east side of 19th Street from Duck Avenue to Flagler Avenue. Approve any necessary budget transfers.

Background:

The current sidewalk along 19th Street runs from Donald Avenue and stops at the curb ramp across Duck Avenue. This project will complete the accessible route to Flagler Avenue with a 5-foot sidewalk, driveway cuts, and ADA ramps. Parallel parking will be maintained with gravel shoulder treatment from sidewalk to edge of pavement. Residents have expressed support for this project.

Purpose and Justification:

This project will close a pedestrian gap, improve safety, and enhance the appearance of the area. This project is consistent with the Key West Strategic Plan, Infrastructure, Goal #1, "*A transportation system which is aesthetically attractive, functional, efficient, safe and environmentally sensitive*".

Financial Issues:

Project to be awarded under the General Utilities & Infrastructure Services contract awarded to CTS via Resolution 21-125. Funding is from Account 102-4102-541-6300, project II41022101, established for ADA sidewalks.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends authorizing the City Manager to approve a task order proposal in the amount of \$106,819.39 to CTS for the construction of a new sidewalk and drainage along the east side of 19th Street from Duck Avenue to Flagler Avenue and approve any necessary budget transfers.
