A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, EXERCISING THE YEAR-TO-YEAR EXTENSION OPTION CONTAINED IN SECTION 6.1 OF THE CONTRACT FOR GENERAL ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING SERVICES WITH PBS&J, NOW KNOWN AS ATKINS NORTH AMERICA, INC. FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE OF COMPLETING TASK ORDER 14 FOR SMATHERS BEACH RENOURISHMENT PHASE II, AND TASK ORDER 15 FOR REST BEACH RENOURISHMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 08-061, the City Commission approved a three-year contract with a two-year renewal option with PBS&J for general environmental consulting services, and in Resolution No. 11-051 the contract was renewed, and in Resolution No. 11-159 the company PBS&J was novated to Atkins North America, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission, having considered staff recommendations, has chosen to renew the contract on a year-to-year basis, as provided in section 6.1 of the contract, for the specific purpose of completing the CEI and monitoring specified in Task Order #14 for CEI and monitoring for Smathers Beach Phase II and Task Order #15 for CEI and monitoring for Rest Beach renourishment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the contract is extended on a year-to-year
basis, pursuant to section 6.1 of the contract documents approved
in Resolution No. 08-061. This extension is granted for the
specific purpose of completing Task Order 14 for Smathers Beach
Renourishment Phase II, and Task Order 15 for Rest Beach
Renourishment.
Section 2: That this Resolution shall go into effect
immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the
signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
