Dear Mr. Scholl:

The Florida Boating Improvement Program (FBIP) Evaluation Committee met on June 21, 2011 to score and rank the applications for fiscal year 2011-2012 funding. Based on the score the application received and its ranking among the other applications, I am pleased to inform you that the project, Truman Presidential Waterfront Park, has been awarded funding in the amount of \$312,000. This award is funded in whole or in part with federal funds through the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). Final award of this grant is contingent upon approval from the USFWS to use federal funds.

Our staff will provide the City of Key West with a grant agreement for review. However, the grant agreement will not be executed until signed by both parties. Do not begin work on the project until the grant agreement is fully executed. The FBIP will not reimburse the City of Key West for any funds spent prior to the execution of a grant agreement unless pre-award costs were requested and pre-approved.
