



### Investigation (continued)

### **Investigation Details**

On the morning of 11.08.24 at about 0540 hours, members of the Special Response Team were executing a High-Risk Search Warrant. The location was 1314 Flagler Ave.

As SRT made their approach to the residence, the team was compromised, as the primary target of the Search Warrant was standing in the front yard and saw us approaching. This target ran inside the residence.

As the SRT made their way into the front yard, there was an SUV backed into the driveway. Ofc Thomas Anglin called out there were occupants in the SUV. He made contact with Subject Hamel in the front passenger seat, and I made contact with a female (information unknown) in the rear passenger seat. The rear door was locked.

I could see and hear Ofc T Anglin giving Hamel orders to get out of the SUV and onto the ground. Hamel physically refused to exit the SUV and displayed active physical resistance. He braced himself within the SUV. I saw Ofc T Anglin using an arm drag technique in an attempt to overcome Hamel's attempts to defeat him physically. Eventually Ofc T Anglin, using Physical Control- takedowns, was able to get Hamel out of the car. Hamel ended up on all fours, hands and knees.

Hamel still refused to get onto the ground in a prone position, and Ofc T Anglin continued the use of the Arm Drag takedown, and eventually redirected Hamel to the ground in a controlled manner. On the ground Hamel was handcuffed and turned over to Detectives on scene.

After SRT cleared the scene, I was made aware of Hamels complaint of pain to his ribs on the right side. Hamel told Detectives on scene that it was from him being taken down. Sgt JT Conaty collected Hamels reporting information and forwarded it to me for purposes of this report. KWFR responded to the scene and evaluated Hamel. He was not transported to the ER.

SRT did not complete reports or take part in the investigative process in this case.
