#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A.H. OF MONROE COUNTY, INC. TO CONDUCT THE ANNUAL TASTE OF KEY WEST AT THE KEY WEST TRUMAN WATERFRONT QUAY WALL ON MONDAY, MARCH 25, 2024, FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 9:00 P.M; ( SET UP STARTING AT 7:00 A.M.); PURSUANT TO TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH BY THE CITY MANAGER; AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE


WHEREAS, A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. wishes to conduct their Annual
"Taste of Key West" at the Key West Truman Waterfront Quay Wall between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Monday, March 25, 2024; and

WHEREAS this event shall take place at the Key West Truman Waterfront Quay Wall during the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on March 25, 2024; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the city Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law."

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic
utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City"

SECTION 3. That A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. is hereby granted permission to conduct their annual "Taste of Key West" on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantee indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. is hereby granted permission allowing the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within an enclosed area.

SECTION 5. That A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. shall be responsible for the rental fee of five hundred dollars $\$ 500.00$ dollars. In addition, A.H. of Monroe County shall be responsible for paying the KWPD, KWFD and Community Services.

SECTION 7. A.H. of Monroe County, Inc. will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for everyone (1) trash barrels will be used that that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
