A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AWARDED THE BID TO MARINO CONSTRUCTION GROUP, INC. RECEIVED IN RESPONSE TO INVITATION TO BID (ITB) #26-002 FOR THE RE-BID NAVY MOLE PIER SEAWALL REPAIR PROJECT IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$796,571.01; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS AND AMENDMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT IN SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West leases from the United States of America through the Department of the Navy a section of the Navy Outer Mole Pier for the specific purpose of cruise ship berthing; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent payments to the Navy for use of the Mole Pier, the City has agreed to perform certain in-kind projects; and

WHEREAS, the Navy Mole Pier Project is necessary to provide replacement for the Navy Exchange Facility at Sigsbee Annex; and

WHEREAS, four bids were received in response to ITB 26-002, with Marino Construction Group, Inc. submitting the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, City staff finds the lowest bid to be responsive and responsible and recommends award of the bid to Marino Construction Group, Inc. in the amount of \$796,571.01.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of Marino Construction Group, Inc. is hereby awarded in response to ITB 26-002 for Re-Bid Navy Mole Pier Project, in an amount not to exceed \$796,571.01.

Section 2: That the project is funded in account 602-1900-519-4600 Project OM19002201. Any additional necessary budget adjustments or amendments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract in substantial conformance with the bid documents upon consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
