I am requesting this transfer due to my hardship that I have to provide primary care for my husband Michael Nelson. He has been a heart patient of Dr. Boros for about 26 years. While we have been very fortunate to have had Michael live all these extra years, we were told in 1987 he would have only a year to live. But with the great care from Dr. Boros and his associates he has the pleasure now of saying Michael is the oldest living heart myopathy patient in the country.

Unfortunately Michael is succumbing to the medications that kept him alive. His body is failing him now. Because of this I will need to be caring for Michael on a daily basis with hospice nurses coming in for daily vital signs and assistance.

I feel morally obligated to care for him in his final time with the family. My daughter and granddaughters are very close to Michael but I do not want them to see or do the things necessary for someone whom is failing.

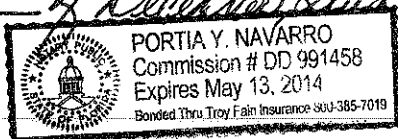
