In reference to your request involving Ms. Lockette's complaint:

- 1. No such video exists for this incident involving Ms. Lockette's complaint. Investigations of minor crashes is not listed in the Mandatory Recording section (06.28.01.02) of the KWPD Body Worn Cameras policy.
- 2. I have attached all CAD notes associated with this incident in the email accompanying this memo.
- 3. I have attached the crash report (23-4489) generated by Officer Alexandre Gaufillet documenting this incident. There are no accompanying pictures as there is no policy requiring pictures be taken for minor crashes.

Based on my research into this incident, I do not believe there to be any violation of KWPD policy or Florida state statute by Officer A. Gaufillet.

Officer A. Gaufillet performed his duties on scene, conducting a full traffic crash investigation. Officer A. Gaufillet spoke to an independent witness on scene, who stated Ms. Lockette drove into the rear of the boat/engine. Officer A. Gaufillet attempted to speak with a witness provided by Ms. Lockette approximately three (3) to four (4), however the witness did not answer or return any of the phone calls. Officer Randall Hartle also attempted to contact the witness provided by Ms. Lockette, but he was not able to speak to her either.

Upon reviewing the CAD Notes and the Traffic Crash Report, Officer A. Gaufillet completed the report accurately with the provided information. Officer A. Gaufillet can still update the report if any new information is provided to him.
