

RESOLUTION NO. 22-105

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA,  
AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR EXTENSION OF THE  
LEASE AGREEMENT WITH ROCKLAND  
OPERATIONS, LLC FOR AS-NEEDED EMERGENCY  
MANAGEMENT DEBRIS STAGING AREA;  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE  
ANY NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, UPON CONSENT OF  
THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN  
EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution 19-055 the City Commission  
authorized an Agreement for Emergency Management Debris  
Staging Area pursuant to RFP No. 002-19; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends exercising the first of up to  
two consecutive one-year extensions of that Agreement, as set  
forth in Sections 4 and 5 of the Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF  
THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a one-year extension of the Lease  
Agreement with Rockland Operations LLC, is hereby authorized  
as described in the attached "Lease between Rockland  
Operations, LLC and the City of Key West."

Section 2: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents to exercise the one-year extension, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

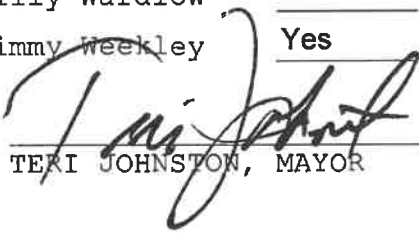
Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
