Renovations and maintenance are needed for the seven bocce courts at Indigenous Park. These courts are the home of the Southernmost Bocce League which consists of fifty-six teams comprised of over 400 players. The League operates two 14-week seasons of play annually, four nights each week, and also hosts playoff and tournament weekends. In addition, the courts are used by recreational players during the day and on non-league nights.

We are proposing to renovate the courts, increasing the length by four feet and creating the required ADA distance of 36 inches between courts. In this process, we also hope to improve court drainage and the overall look of the park space.

We hope to complete this project during the League's off-season which begins December 6 and runs through mid-February.
