A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, DIRECTING ACTION BY THE CITY MANAGER REGARDING COOPERATION WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT CONCERNING OBLIGATIONS FOR REPLACEMENT OF RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AT POINCIANA SCHOOL; DIRECTING THE MANAGER AND CITY ATTORNEY TO COLLABORATIVELY WITH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR THE ENFORCEMENT, AMENDMENT AND/OR EXTENSION OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF KEY WEST; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Key West and the Monroe County School Board entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the installation and use of recreational facilities at Poinciana School in 1990; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Interlocal Agreement, the City expended considerable funds for the installation of recreational amenities, including soccer fields, lighting with associated poles and a concession stand; and

WHEREAS, the 1990 Interlocal has a term of 25 years; and

WHEREAS, when Poinciana School was reconstructed, the facilities constructed by the City of Key West on the site were destroyed by the School District; and

WHEREAS, the School District represented they would reconstruct the facilities at the site along Glynn Archer Drive; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the reconstruction of Poinciana

School, City of City West granted the School District an easement of approximately 38,115 square feet (.875 acres) for parking adjacent to the proposed soccer fields to the South of Poinciana School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West donated more than \$250,000 worth of fill for the replacement of fields at Poinciana School; and

WHEREAS, the School District has recently constructed fields at the site, but failed to replace the poles, lights or concession stand; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West has offered to provide lighting fixtures for the fields; and

WHEREAS, the City of Key West desires to ensure complete replacement of the facilities at Poinciana for the benefit of the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager shall engage the School District in discussions to collaboratively devise a plan for the immediate and complete replacement of recreational facilities at Poinciana School. The first objective of replacement shall be poles and lights for nighttime use of the facilities.

Section 2: That the City Manager and City Attorney shall work collaboratively with the School District to equitably enforce, Page 2 of 3

amend and/or extend Interlocal Agreements regarding recreational facilities in the City to provide for the benefit of the children and residents of the community.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

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
