A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A PURCHASE FROM REV-RTC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$501,486 FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2025 E-ONE HEAVY RESCUE APPARATUS WITH ASSOCIATED OPTIONS AND EQUIPMENT, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CONTRACT, SECTION 2-797(3) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING PURSUANT TO SECTION 2-771(3)(c) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS AND OBSOLETE CITY-OWNED APPARATUS, EQUIPMENT, AND IMPROVEMENTS, THROUGH A TRADE-IN SALE TO REV-RTC FOR THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000, AUTHORIZING NECESSARY BUDGET TRANSFERS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Fire Department administrative staff recommends the purchase of a heavy rescue apparatus, including all necessary options and equipment from REV-RTC, under the Florida Sheriff's Association (FSA) Bid No. FSA 23-VEF 17.0 for fire rescue vehicles and other equipment, pursuant to section 2-797(3) of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends disposal of (2) city-owned surplus fire apparatus, 2007 Pierce 75' aerial (\$125,000) and 2004 Pierce pumper (\$25,000), through a trade-in sale to REV-RTC; and

WHEREAS, Code of Ordinances Section 2-771.3. (c) provides

that disposal of surplus or obsolete personal property with acquisition prices in excess of \$50,000.00 shall be made only after approval by the City Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a purchase from REV-RTC in an amount not to exceed \$501,486 for one 2025 E-One Heavy Rescue Apparatus with all associated options and equipment is hereby approved, pursuant to Section 2-797(3) of the code of ordinances.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby authorizes disposal of (2) apparatus, equipment, and improvements, described as 2007 Pierce 75' aerial, VIN 4P1CVO1H37A007460 (\$125,000) and 2004 Pierce Pumper, VIN 4PICE01U04A004315 (\$25,000), pursuant to section 2- 771(3)(c), through a trade-in sale to REV-RTC in the total amount of \$150,000.

Section 3: That funds in the amount of \$564,000 are budgeted for this acquisition and allocated in FY 22/23 Fire Department Infrastructure Fund under Budget account 101-2201-522-6400. Necessary budget transfers and adjustments from the Infrastructure Surtax Fund are hereby authorized.

Section 4: That the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute necessary documents related to this purchase and sale upon advice and consent of the City

Attorney.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
