

RESOLUTION NO. 23-260

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE UNITED STATES NAVY TO HOLD THE ANNUAL VETERANS DAY PARADE ON DUVAL STREET FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M. (SET UP STARTING AT 2:00 P.M.) SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2023; AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS OR PORTIONS THEREOF FOR SAID PARADE FROM 4:00 P.M. TO 7:00 P.M.; WAIVING ALL FEES FOR REQUIRED CITY SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida, as follows:

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to “develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law.”

SECTION 2. “That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City’s concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and

“To go” packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the City.”

SECTION 3. That the United States Navy is hereby granted permission to hold the annual Veterans Day Parade on Duval Street from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday, November 11, 2023, and the City will close portions thereof from 2:00 p.m. to approximately 7:00 p.m. for said parade and set up. The parade will start on Duval and Julio, continue down Duval Street and end at Front Street.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 6-26 (c), for cause shown upon the record, a special exception to the requirement of payment for required city services set forth in Section 6-26 (a) is hereby granted, waiving all fees for required city services for the Veterans Day Parade.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officers and Clerk of the Commission.
