A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, OPPOSING FLORIDA SENATE BILL 586, WHICH, IF PASSED, WOULD REVISE THE DISTRIBUTION OF REVENUE FROM THE TAX ON DOCUMENTS, SUBSTANTIALLY REDUCING AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City staff has received notice that the Florida Legislature is considering SB 586, which would revise the distribution of funds for state and local affordable housing trust funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that this proposed legislation will do significant and permanent harm to affordable housing if no changes are made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Key West City Commission strongly opposes proposed SB 586 and urges its legislators to oppose such measures.

Section 2: That the City Clerk is hereby authorized to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to Representative Raschein, Senator Bullard, and Governor Rick Scott and members of the House and Senate leadership.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the presiding officer and the Clerk of the Commission.
