

RESOLUTION NO. 22-208

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A SUBMISSION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY BEAUTIFICATION GRANT FOR PHASE TWO - LANDSCAPING PROJECT ON U.S. 1 (STATE ROAD 5) BETWEEN COW KEY BRIDGE AND COLLEGE ROAD (THE TRIANGLE), IN AN AMOUNT OF UP TO \$100,000.00 FOR THIS GRANT CYCLE (FY 22/23); AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS UPON CONSENT OF THE CITY ATTORNEY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the US 1 entrance to Key West (known as "The Triangle") is being improved, and the City of Key West seeks grant funding in support of Phase Two of the landscape improvements in the vicinity of the proposed New Welcome Sign, in exchange for providing ongoing maintenance of those improvements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That submission to FDOT of an application for a Right of Way Beautification Grant for Phase Two - Landscaping Project for the entrance to Key West along US 1 (State Road 5) (commonly known as "The Triangle") is hereby authorized in an amount of up to \$100,000.00 in FY 22/23.

Section 2: As a condition of receiving beautification grant funds, the City would agree to accept ongoing maintenance responsibility for such improvements within the project limits.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute the grant application and agreements and related documents associated with the grant, upon the advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.


