Honorable Mayor and Commissioners,

On behalf of the Board of Trustees for the General Employee Pension, a vote on the May 10, 2024, pension meeting for the DROP extension failed 4-1. (minutes attached). There are several questions the board has regarding the potential long-term cost.

When an employee enters the DROP the amount of their monthly benefit is calculated at that time based on their service years, accrued service. The employees enrolled in the DROP program will not receive the benefits of increases in their salaries to determine their monthly compensation for the time they are in the DROP. When a member enters the DROP they are considered retired for pension purposes and their benefits are invested as part of the plan.

The members of the plan will potentially not be considered for advancements. This change could potentially have an increased number of non-contributing members in the Plan.

Please consider delaying your vote until the Board of Trustees can research fully the financial impact on the plan and the city.
