

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of our island City to establish a positive, dynamic and

strong relationship with Cuba, our closest neighbor to the South; and

WHEREAS the islands of Cuba and Key West have a long and storied history which has

endured generations with a bright and promising future ahead; and

WHEREAS while legislative and diplomatic relations between the nation of Cuba and the

United States are generally under the purview of the Federal government, there are occasions for which it is appropriate for a designee of the Mayor of the City of Key West to occupy a ceremonial position and participate in Key West-Cuba

exchanges; and

WHEREAS Key West is best positioned both geographically and historically to lead renewed

relations with our island neighbor in the spirit of goodwill and cooperation for the

benefit of all citizens and nations; and

WHEREAS Mayor Craig Cates and Robert D. Harvey have had several opportunities both

individually and collectively to meet with representatives of the people and

government of Cuba; and

WHEREAS the Mayor requires a trusted, balanced and even-tempered diplomat to help

him serve the City of Key West in relations with Cuba; and

NOW, THEREFORE I, Mayor Craig Cates, hereby officially recognize and designate
